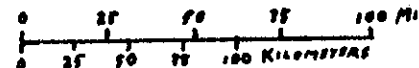
RANCH HAND Unit Insignia

Designed in 1962 by Captain Allen Kidd and Lieutenant John Hodgins, the insignia symbolized various aspects of the RANCH HAND organization. The red lettering on a yellow circle represented the close association of the unit with the Republic of Vietnam, whose national colors were red and yellow. The brown stripe across a green field depicted a defoliation swath through a forest. The silver calligraphy in the center of the stripe was the Chinese character for the word "Purple," the code name for the first primary herbicide used by RANCH HAND in Vietnam, and the color of the scarves worn by unit members.

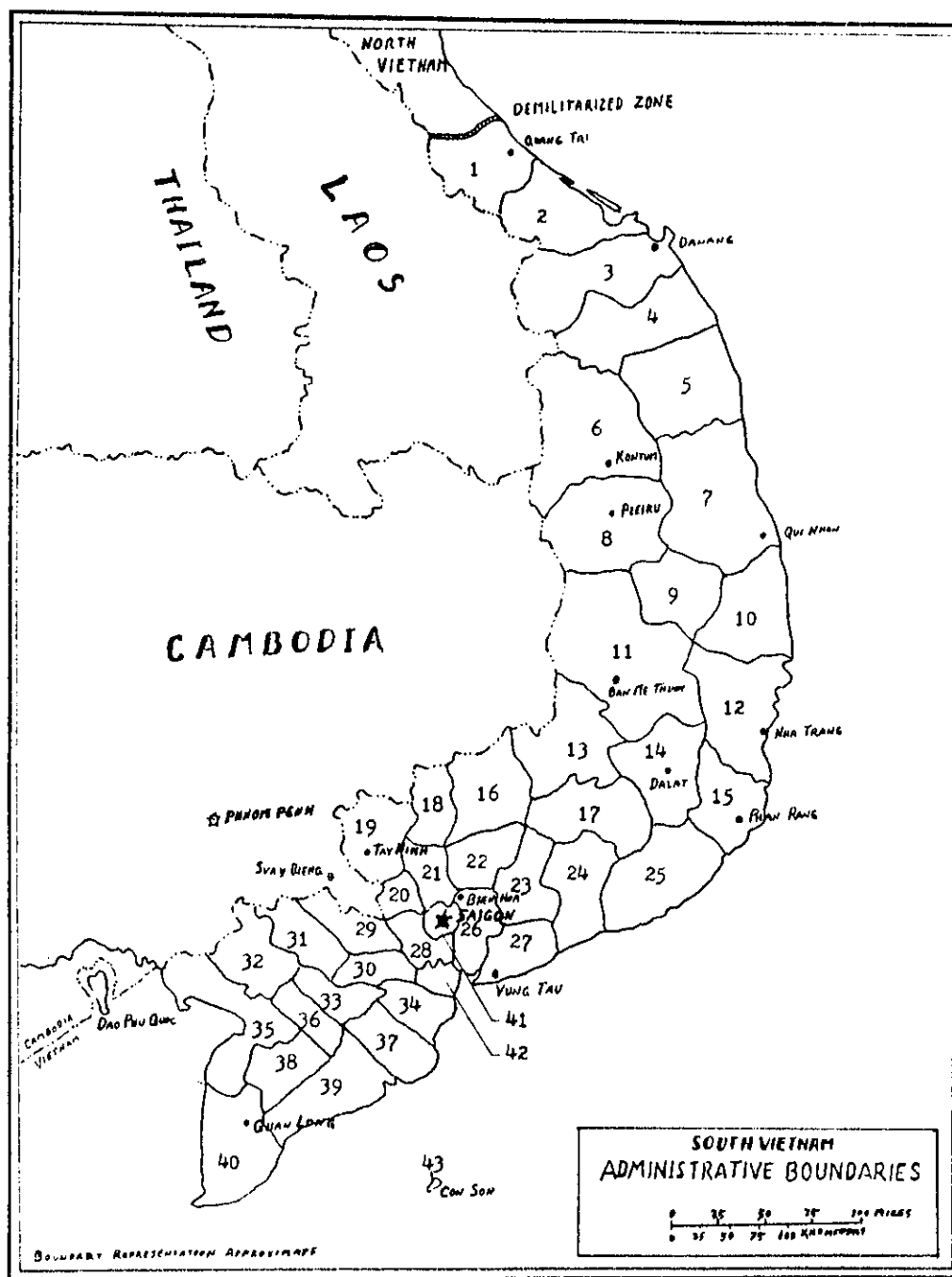




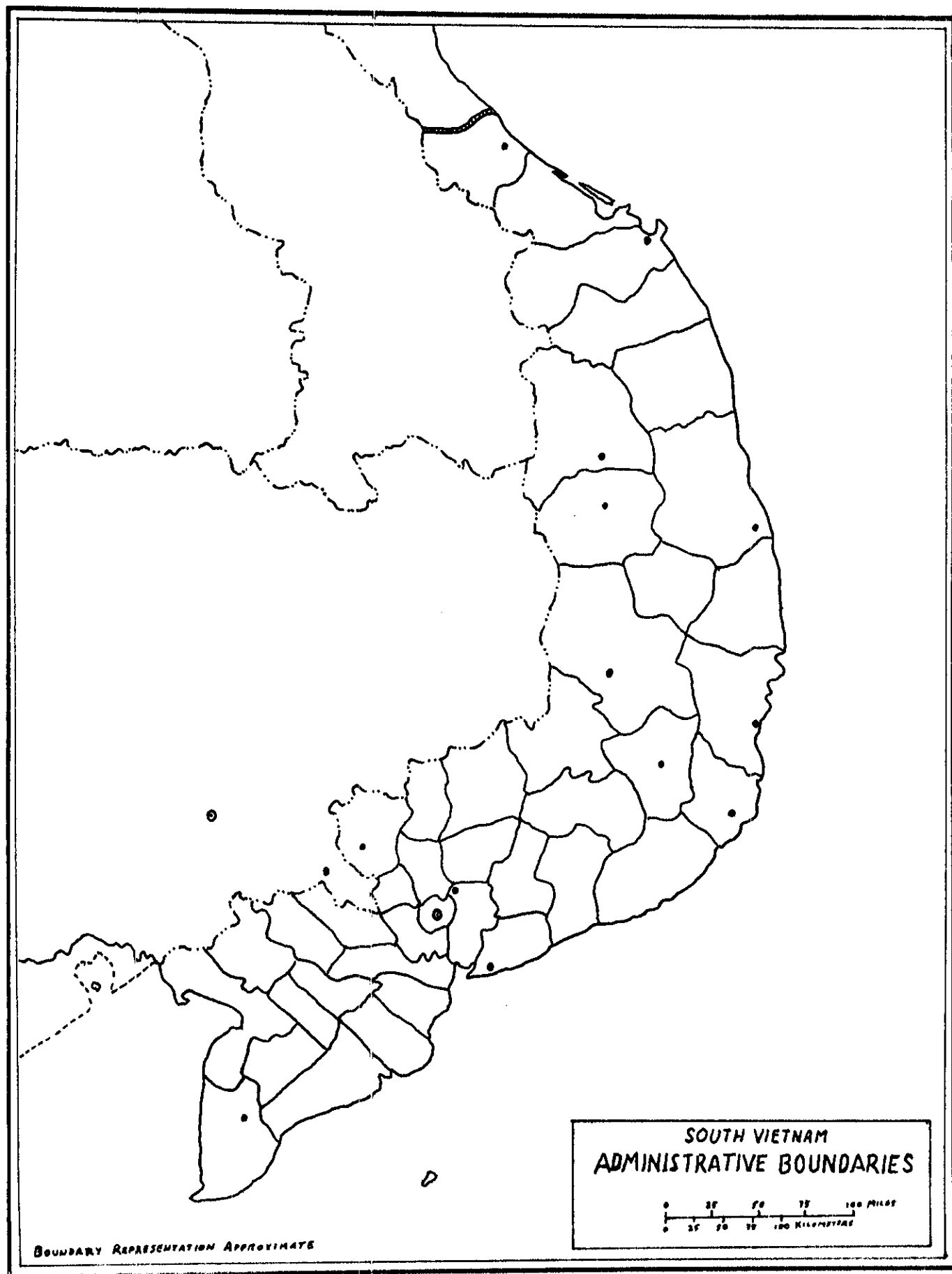

Map of Administrative Boundaries (see previous page for names).







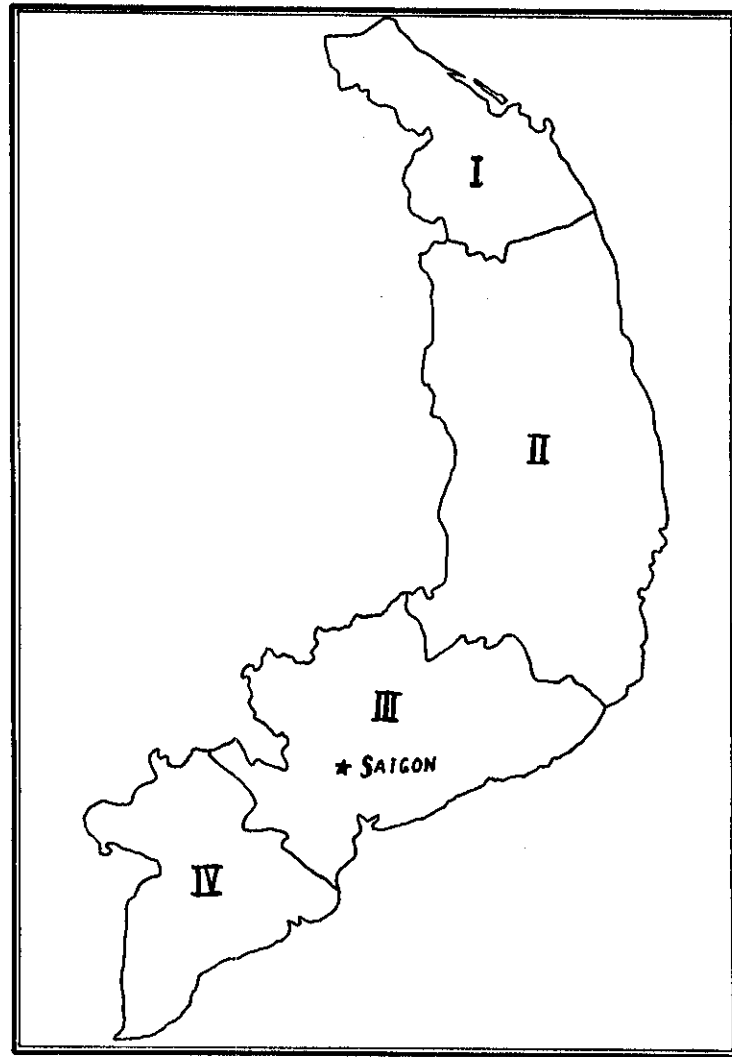
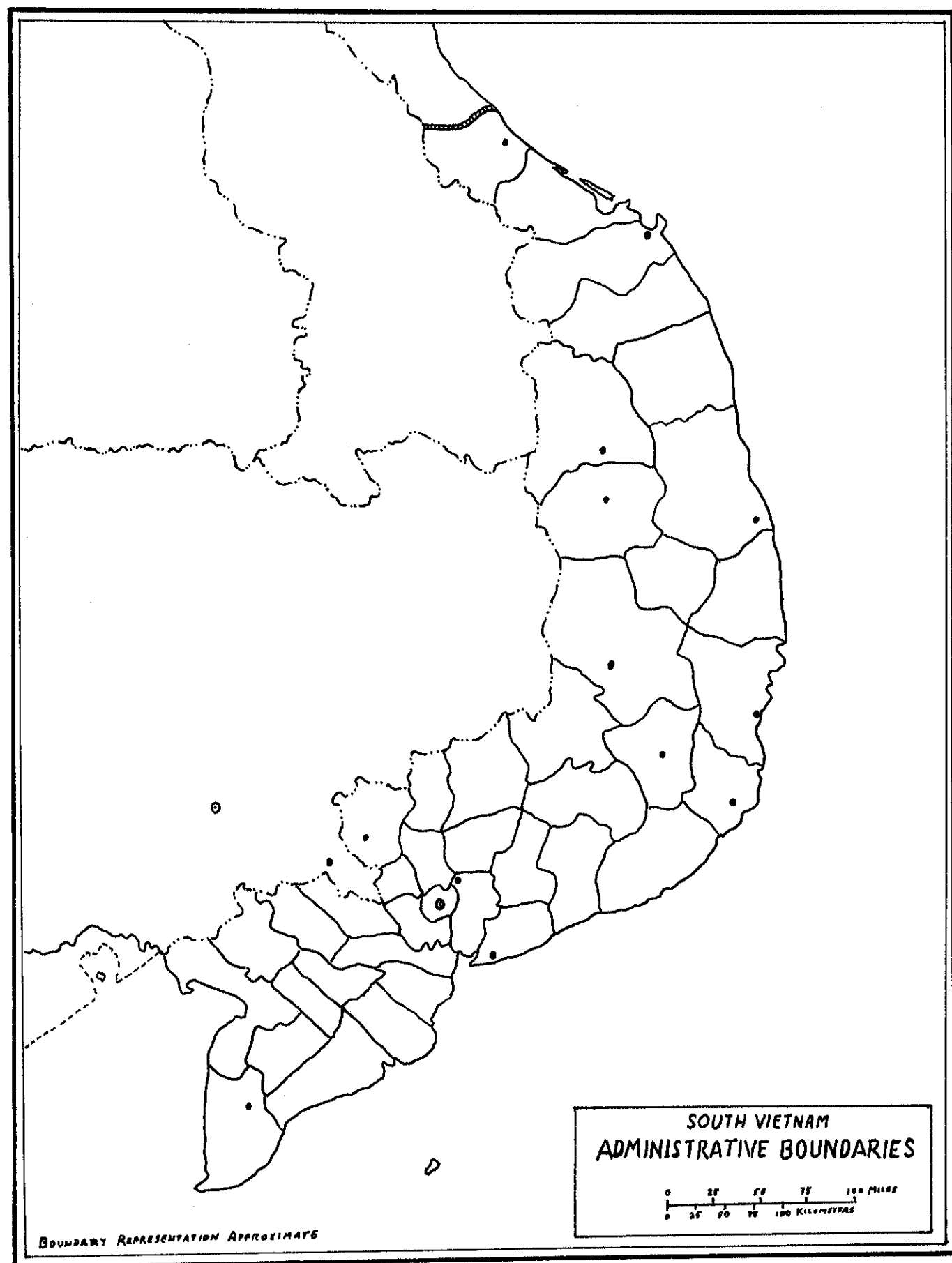
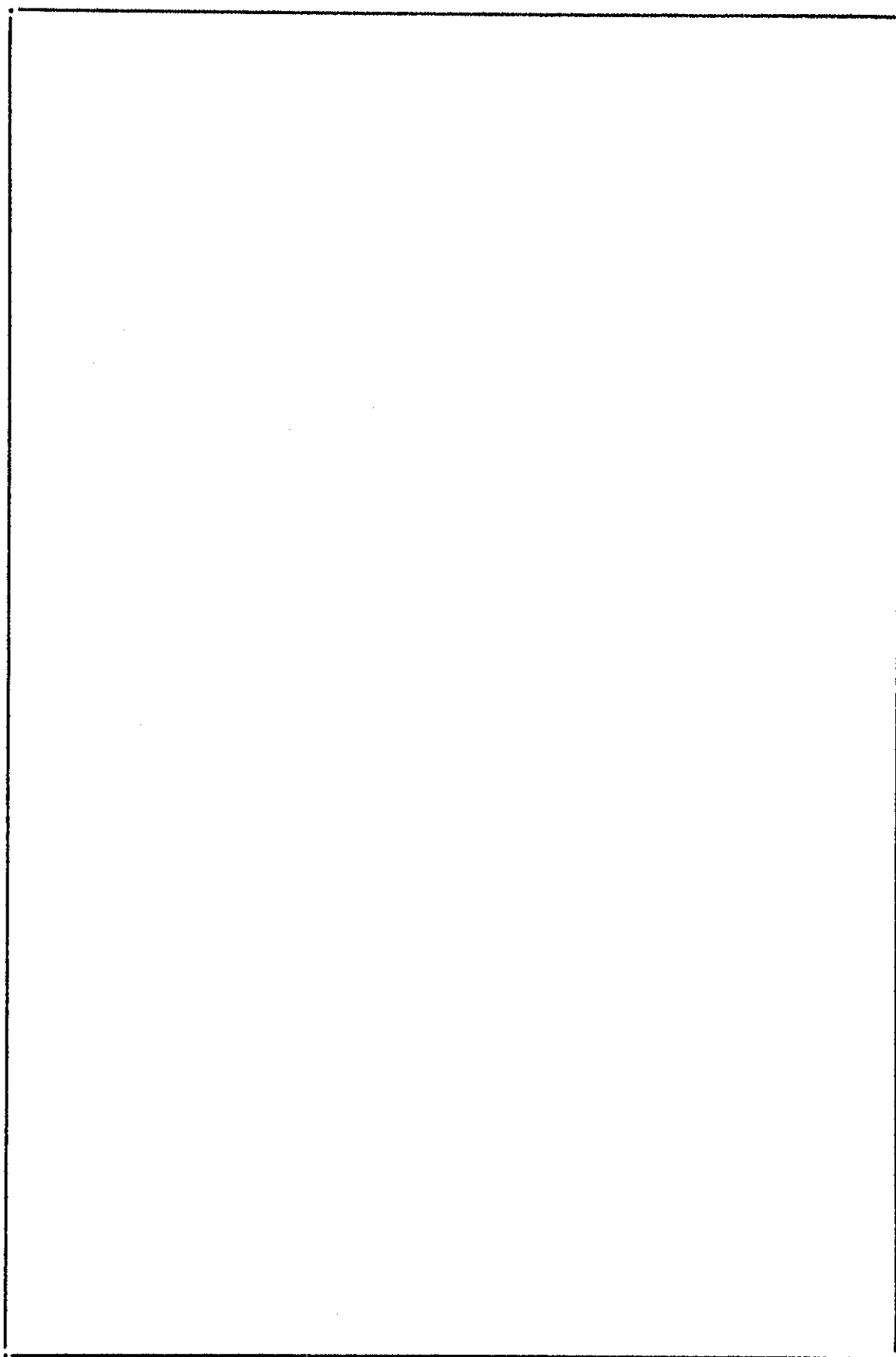
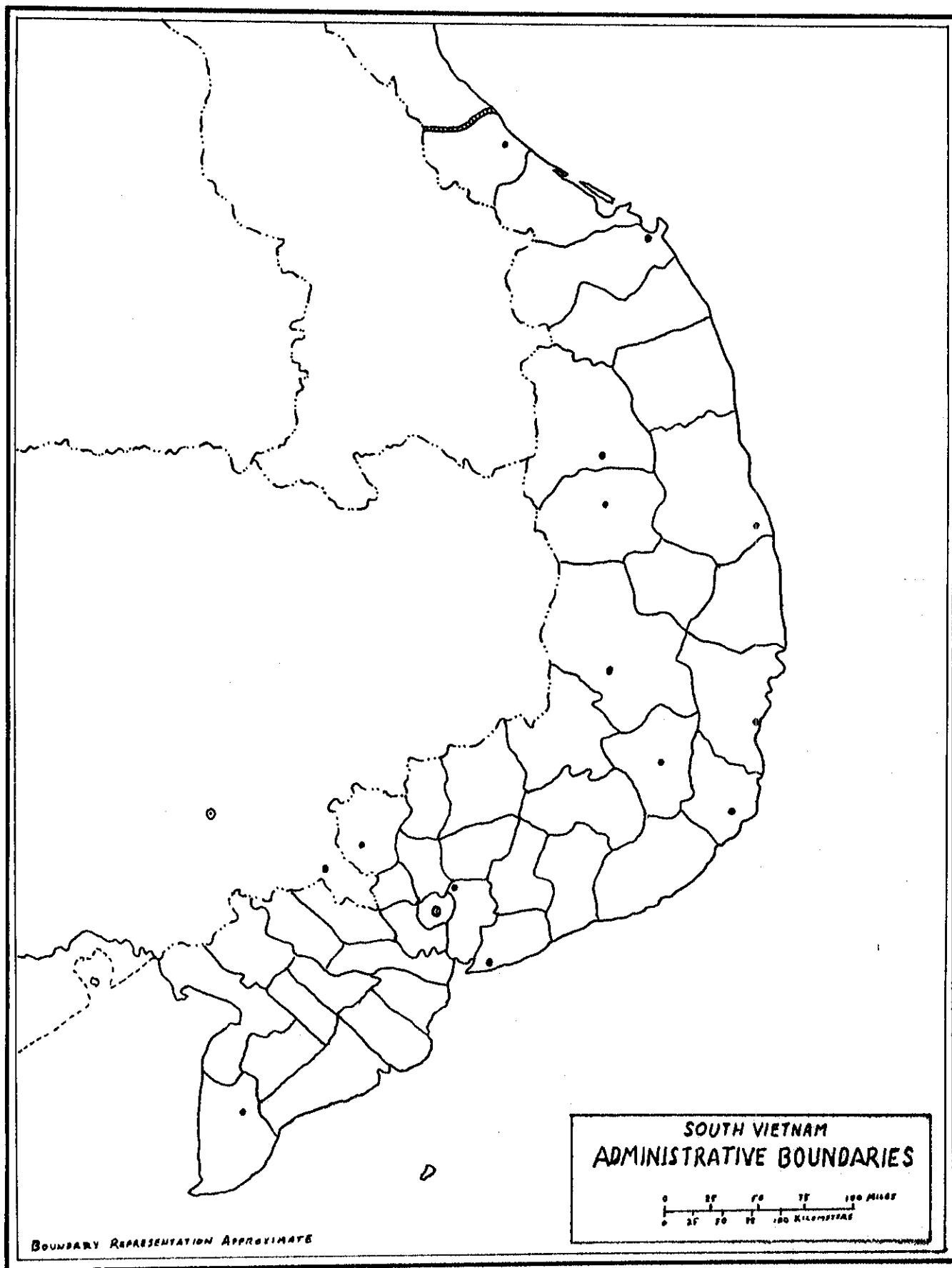


Figure 1. Corps Tactical Zones (CTZ) - South Vietnam

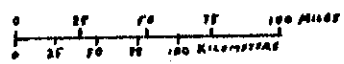

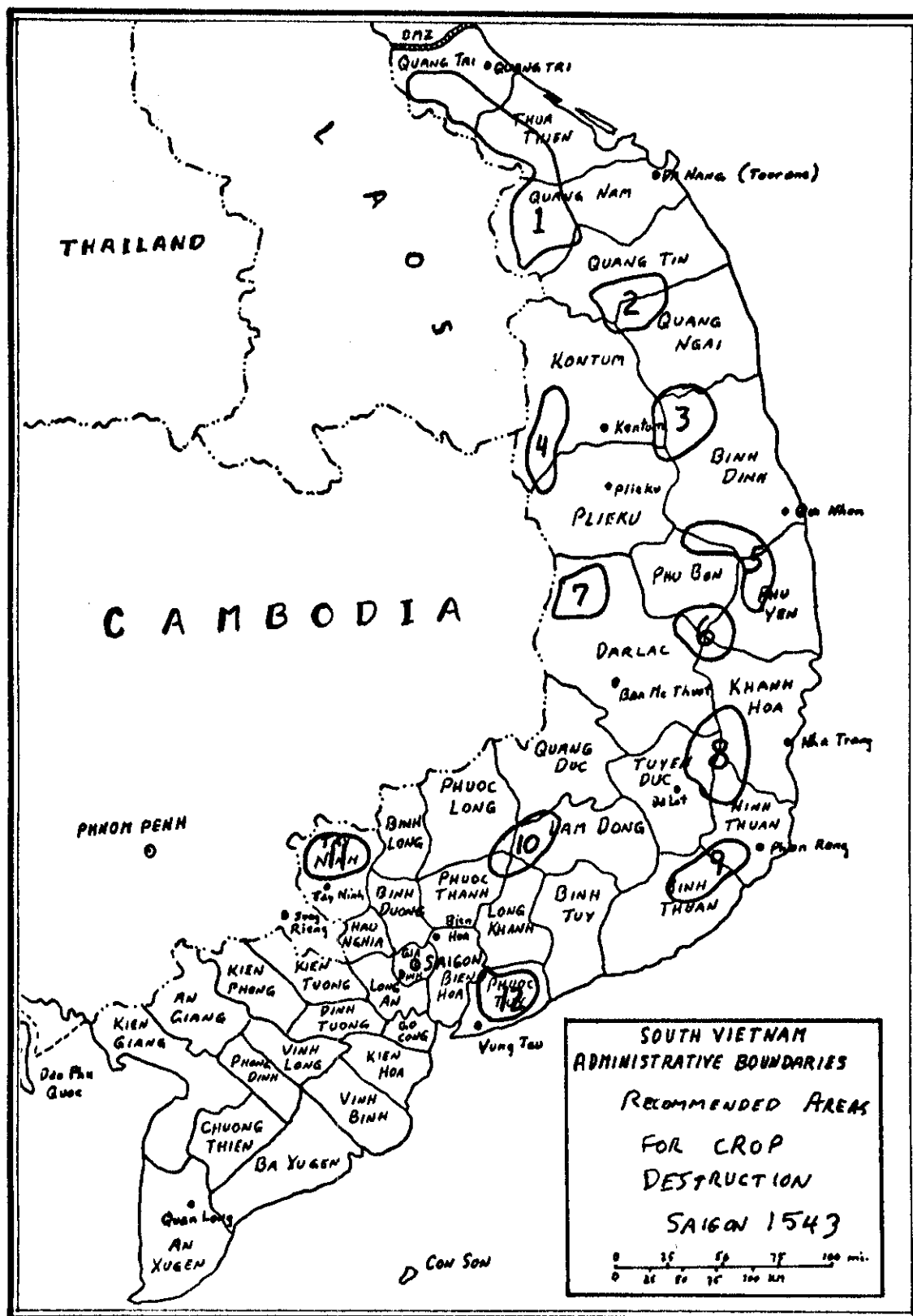


Figure 2. Reproduction: Recommended Areas for Crop Destruction¹

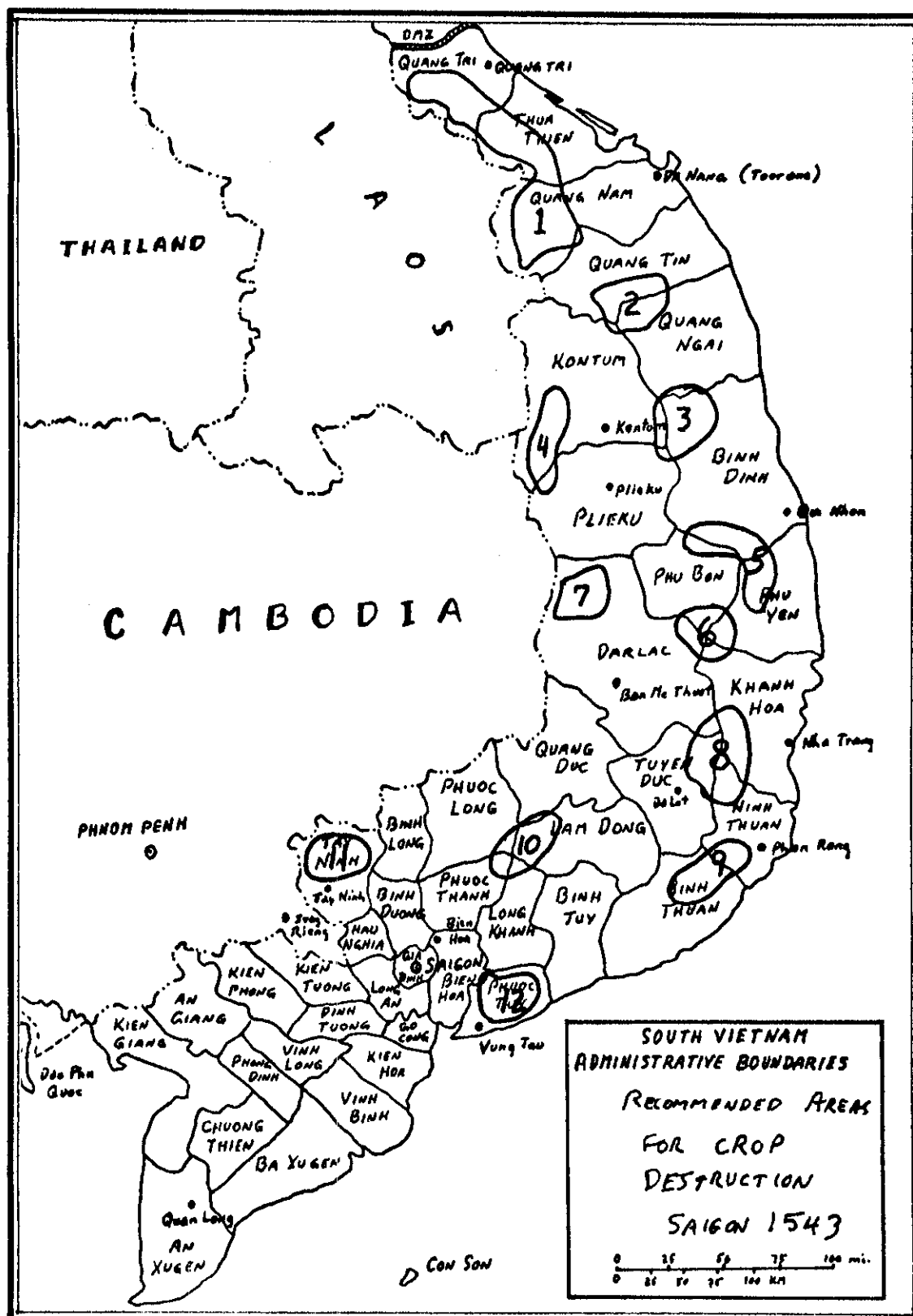
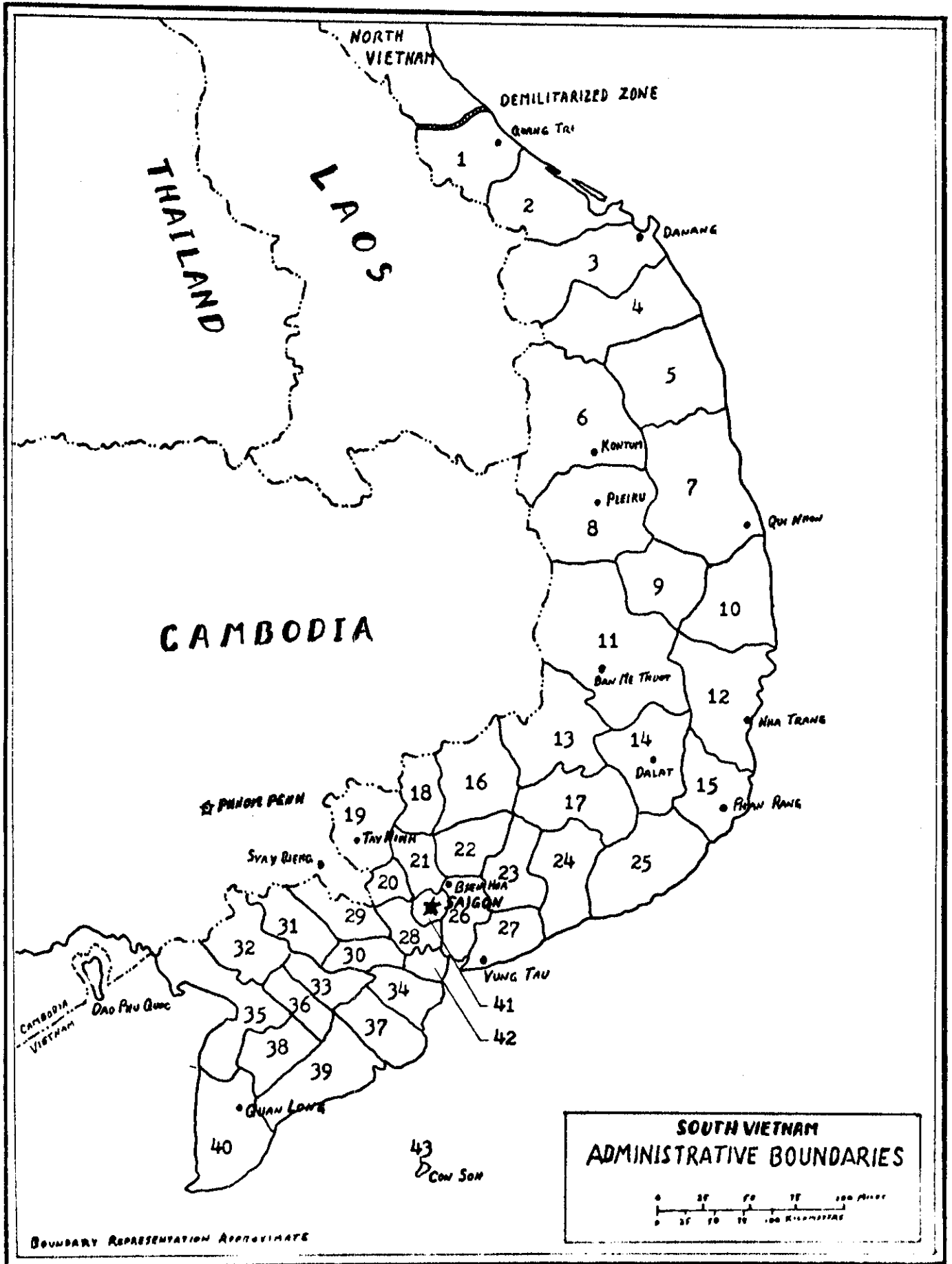
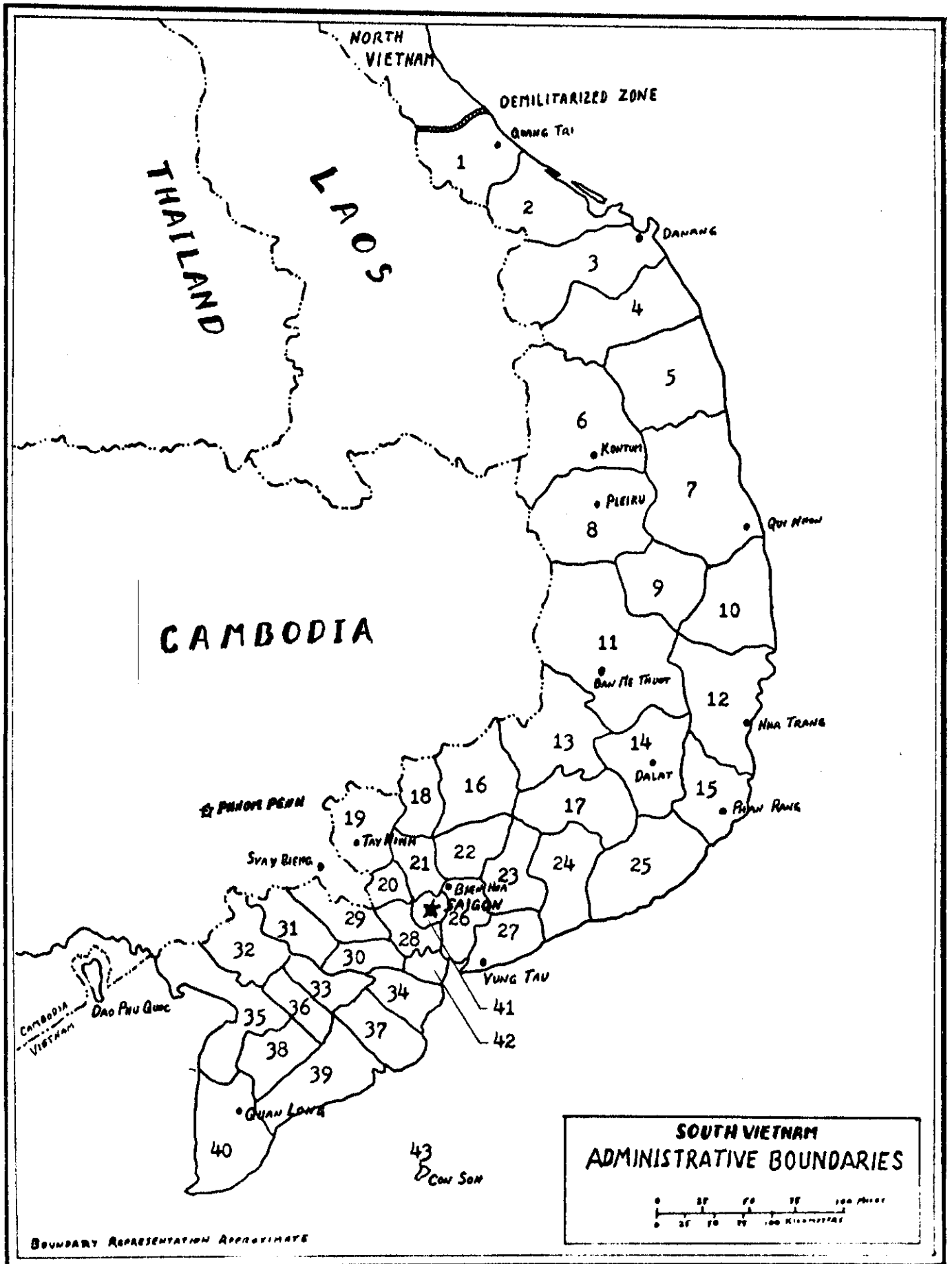
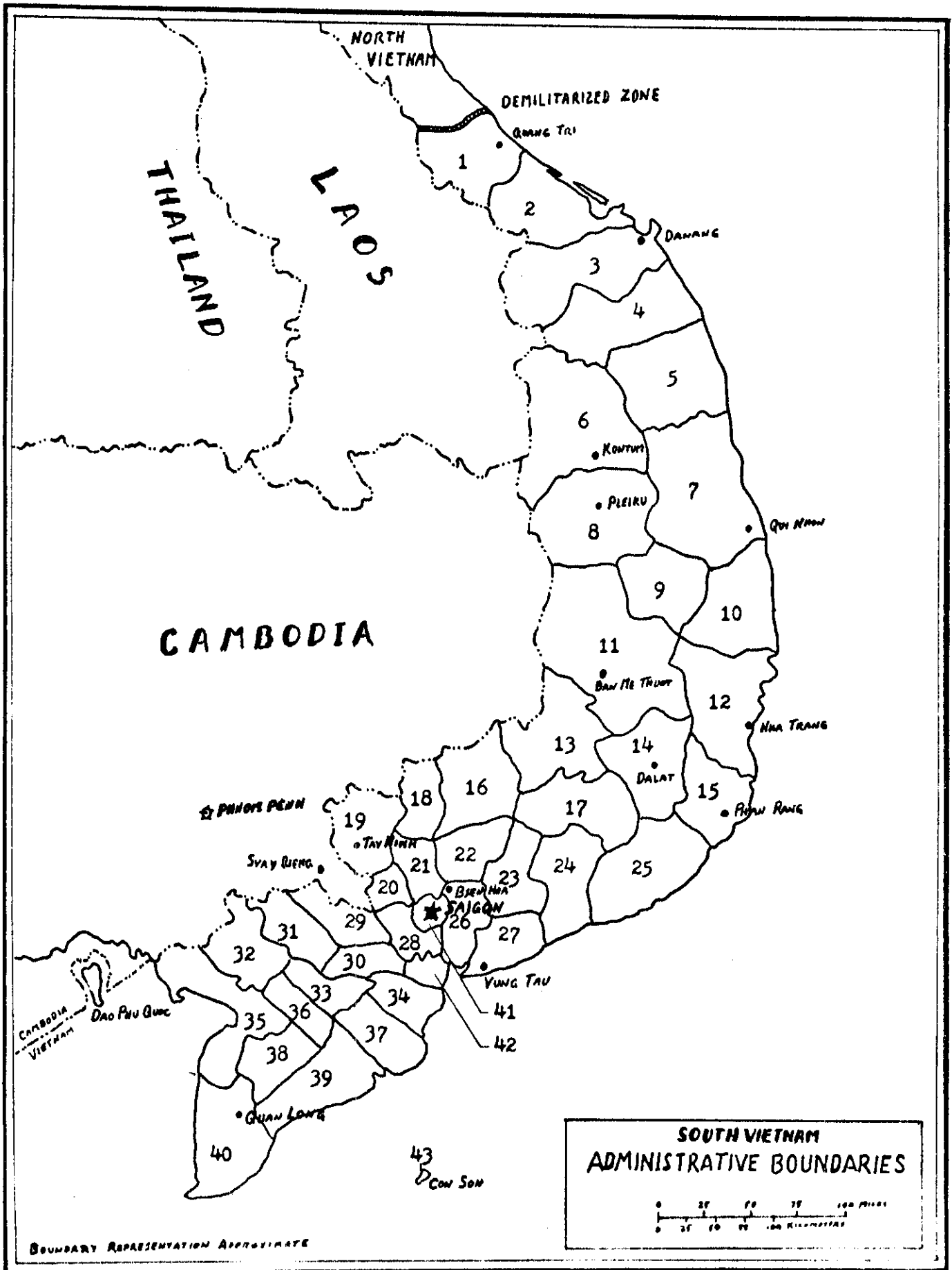
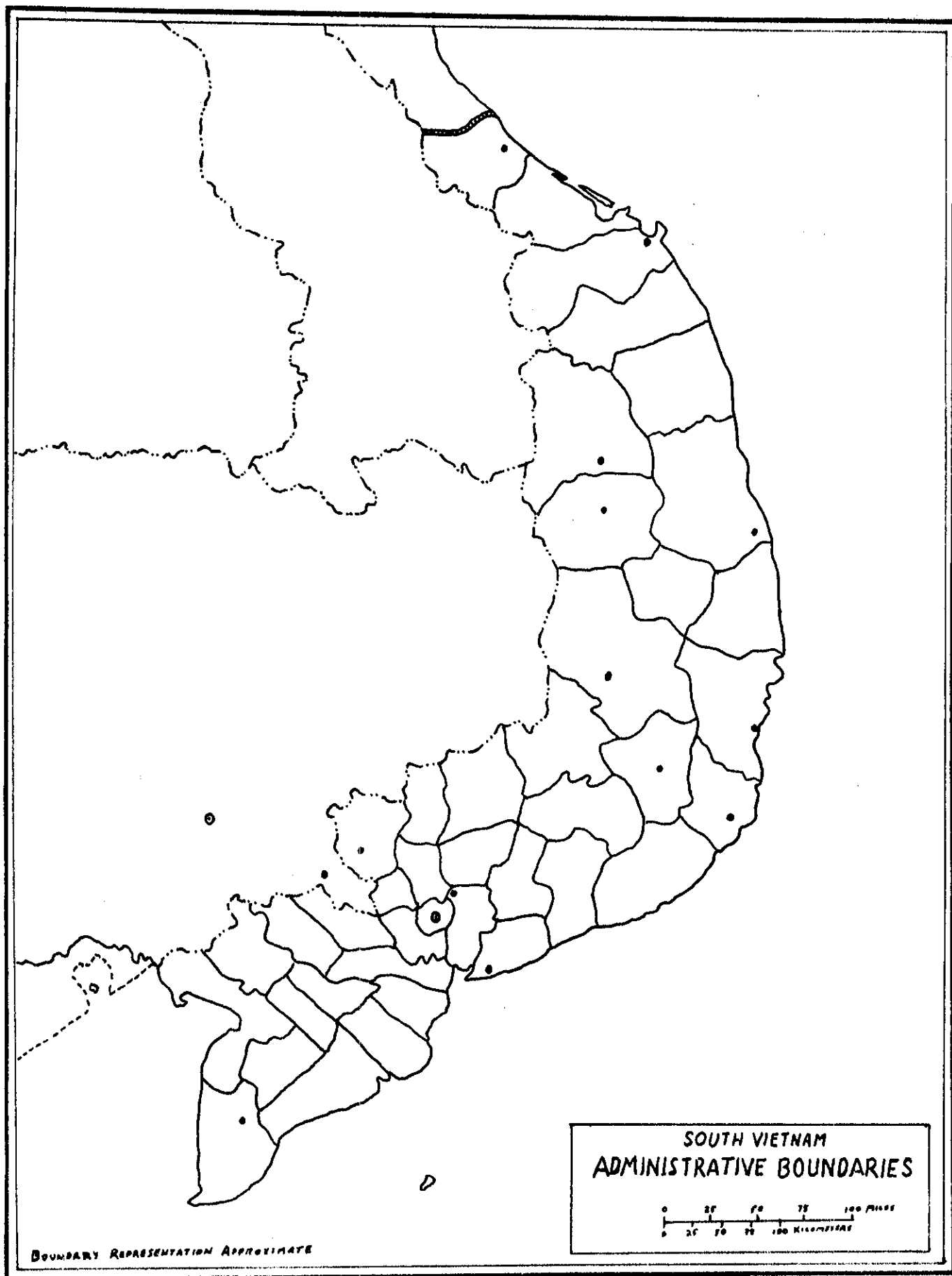


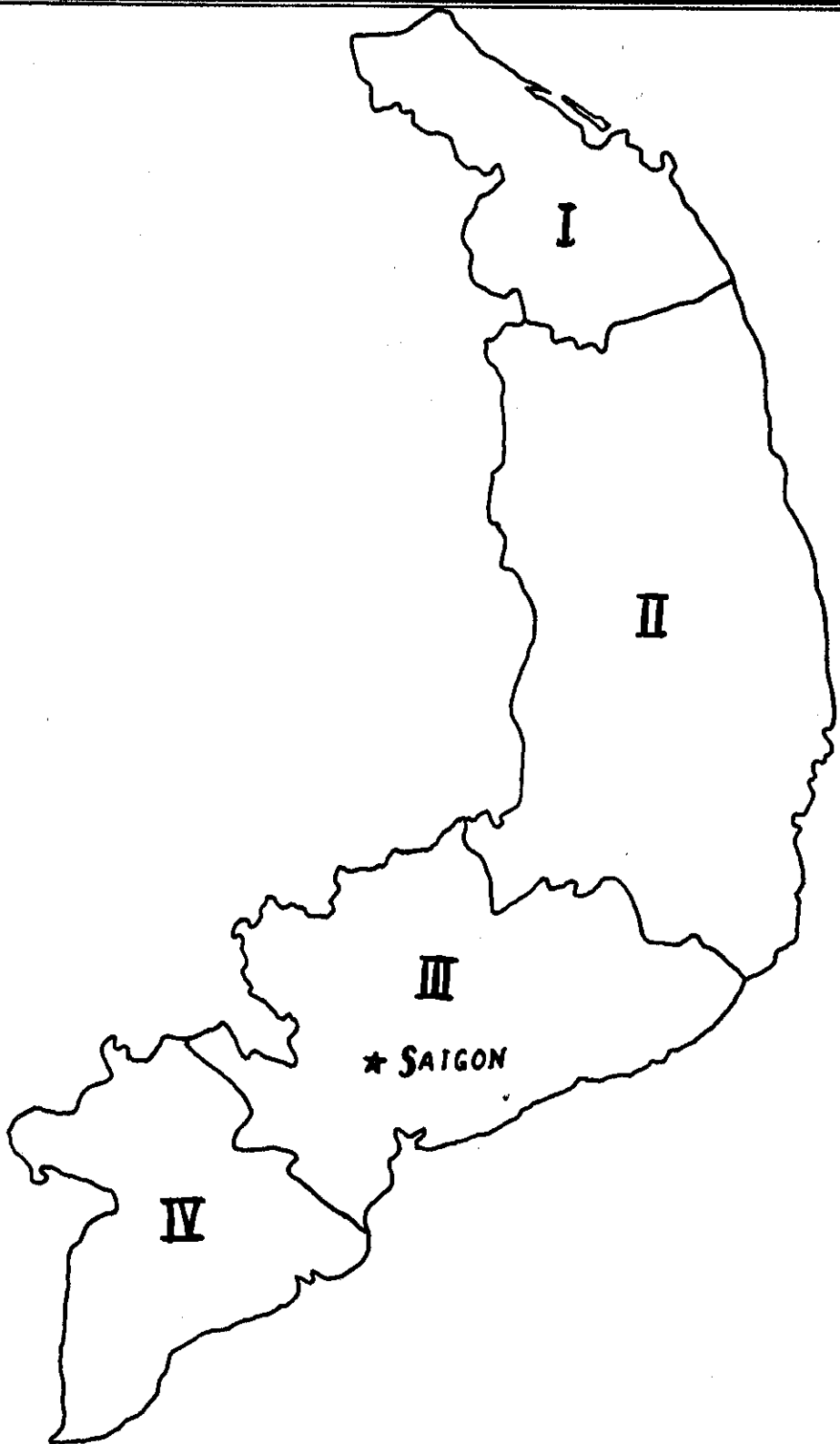
Figure 2. Reproduction: Recommended Areas for Crop Destruction¹

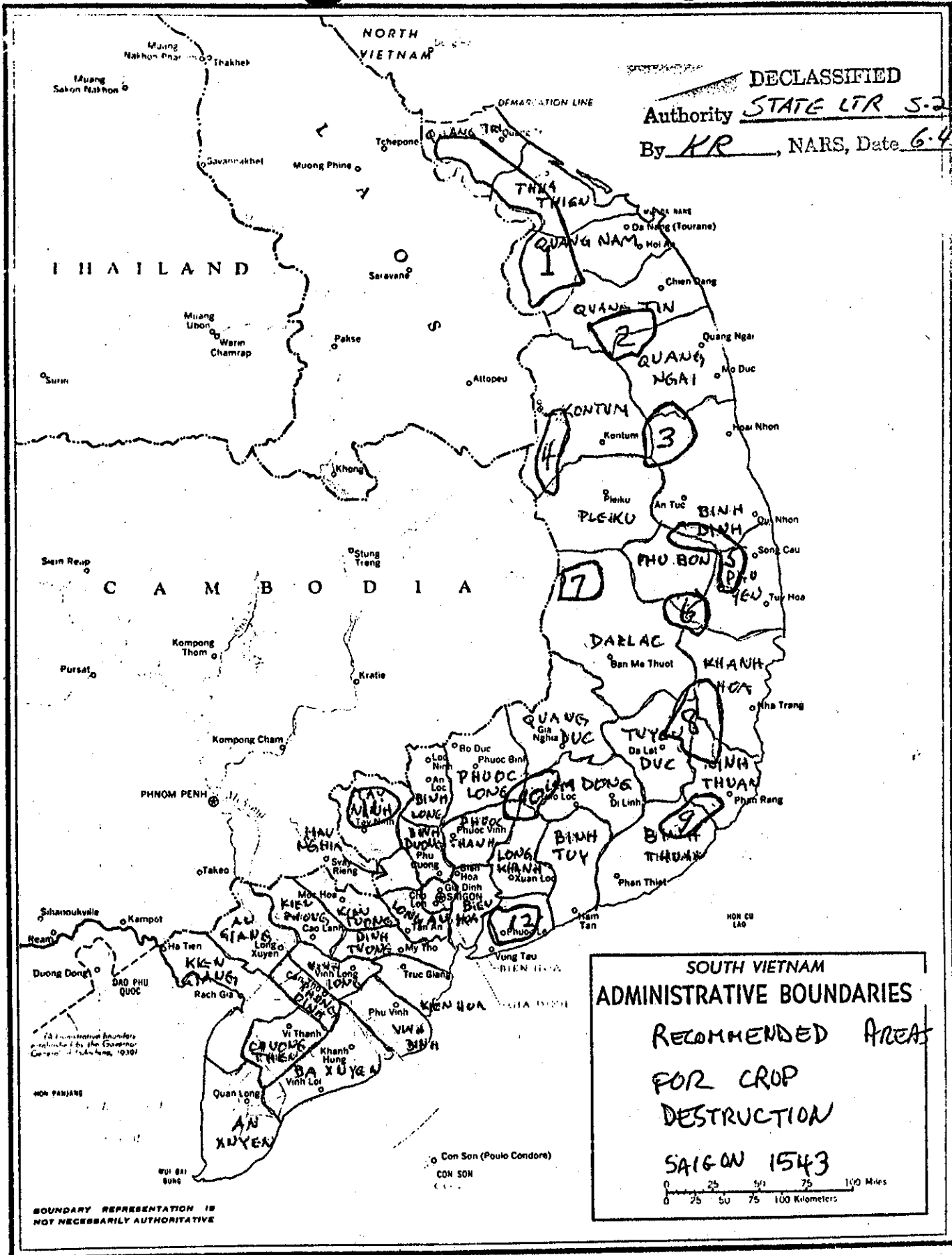
