Data on spray distribution needs to be completed.

Were the herbicides diluted?

Aircraft flying a different pattern for crop destruction. One aircraft would circle while the other would do a 360-degree circle within the clearing. The crop was located next to the tree line, not in the center of the clearing.

Stellman exposure scenario – distribution extended to 5 km; less than 20% relative dose at 400 meters.

RANCH HAND aircraft moving at 130 Knots and 150 ft AGL.

Send spray swath information to Michael.

Do we include a photograph of a DAAR in the manuscript?

Reading the DAAR. Project No. may be significantly earlier than the mission date. On the DAAR, the mission number 7-526, means the 526th mission, conducted in July, for that year (1968).

Data on friendly fire has been located and the records support the FAC/RH information that friendlies were not on the ground near RH missions.
