AGENT ORANGE NAL REFERENCE LIST

The Alvin L. Young Collection on Agent Orange contains >7,500 documents. The documents are identified by item, folder, and box. There are 6,576 folders in 229 Letter Boxes. Approximately 1,600 of the items were scanned and catalogued for Internet access. At this time, they are not available by Internet.
