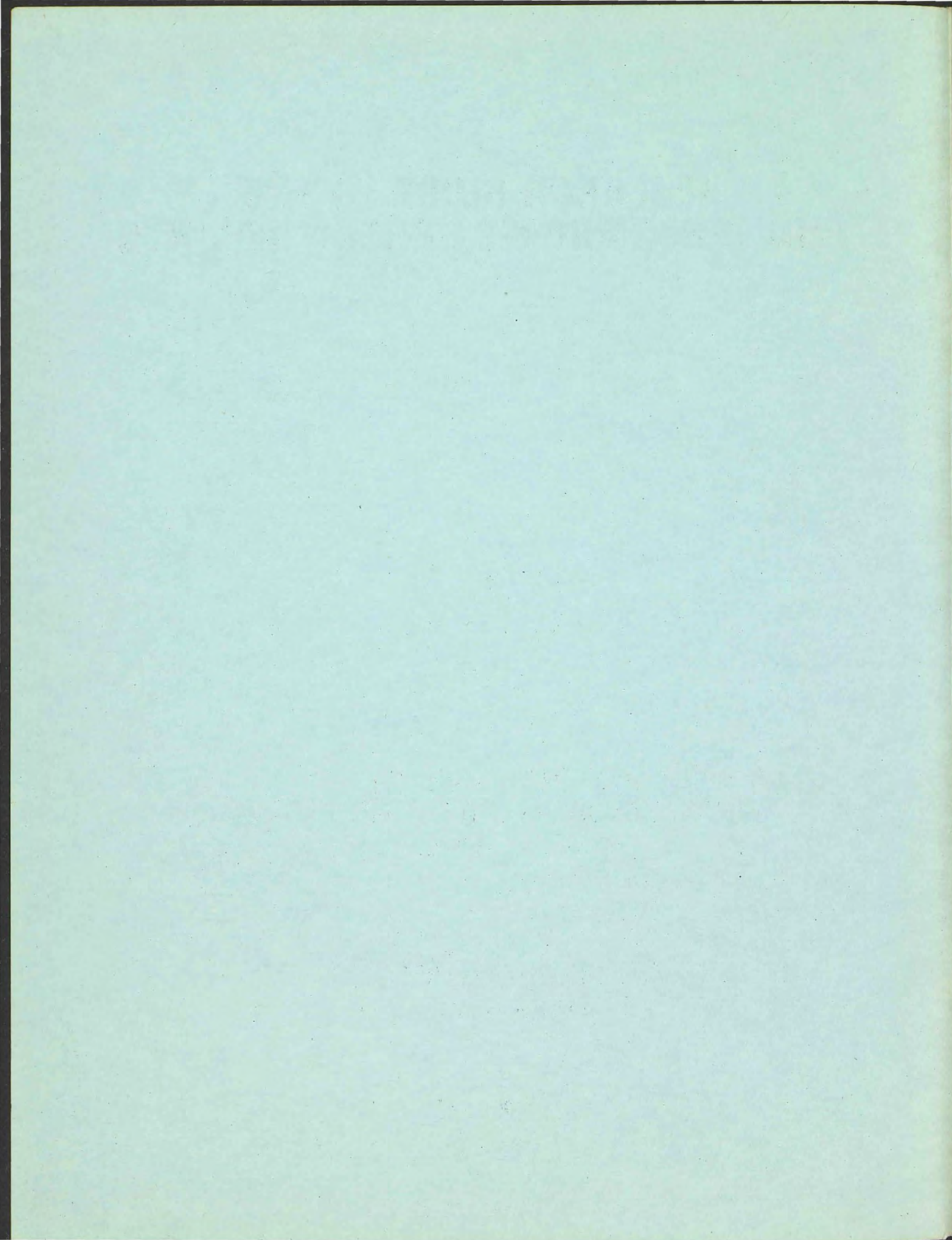

## INTRODUCTION

Project CHECO\* began in June 1962 when the Air Force Chief of Staff directed its establishment at HQ Pacific Air Forces (PACAF) and the 2nd Air Division (redesignated 7th Air Force in 1966) to compile, document, analyze, and report on a timely basis the "new forces, new tactics and techniques, new materials, and new methods" being employed in aerial operations in Southeast Asia (SEA). Until 30 June 1975, CHECO personnel--operating out of South Vietnam and, later, Thailand--researched, wrote reports, and microfilmed record files covering the operational activities of the U. S. Air Force in SEA.

To date, 218 reports have been published. Several additional reports are being prepared at PACAF. When completed, they will be included in an amendment to this guide. The collection of microfilmed documents is available at the Albert F. Simpson Historical Research Center (AFSHRC).

This guide is divided into two parts. The first consists of descriptive data and an abstract for each published CHECO report. The second consists of a subject index to the published CHECO reports. AFSHRC has assigned numbers to the reports which approximate the chronological order. In the index, the numbers following each reference indicate a CHECO report listed in Part One and not a page number.

The call number of each item consists of two parts: the printed copy number with a prefix K717 followed by a diagonal mark (/) then the microfilm call number. Example: K717.0414-36/30, 500-354. Numbers enclosed by parenthesis refer to PACAF/CHECO call numbers.

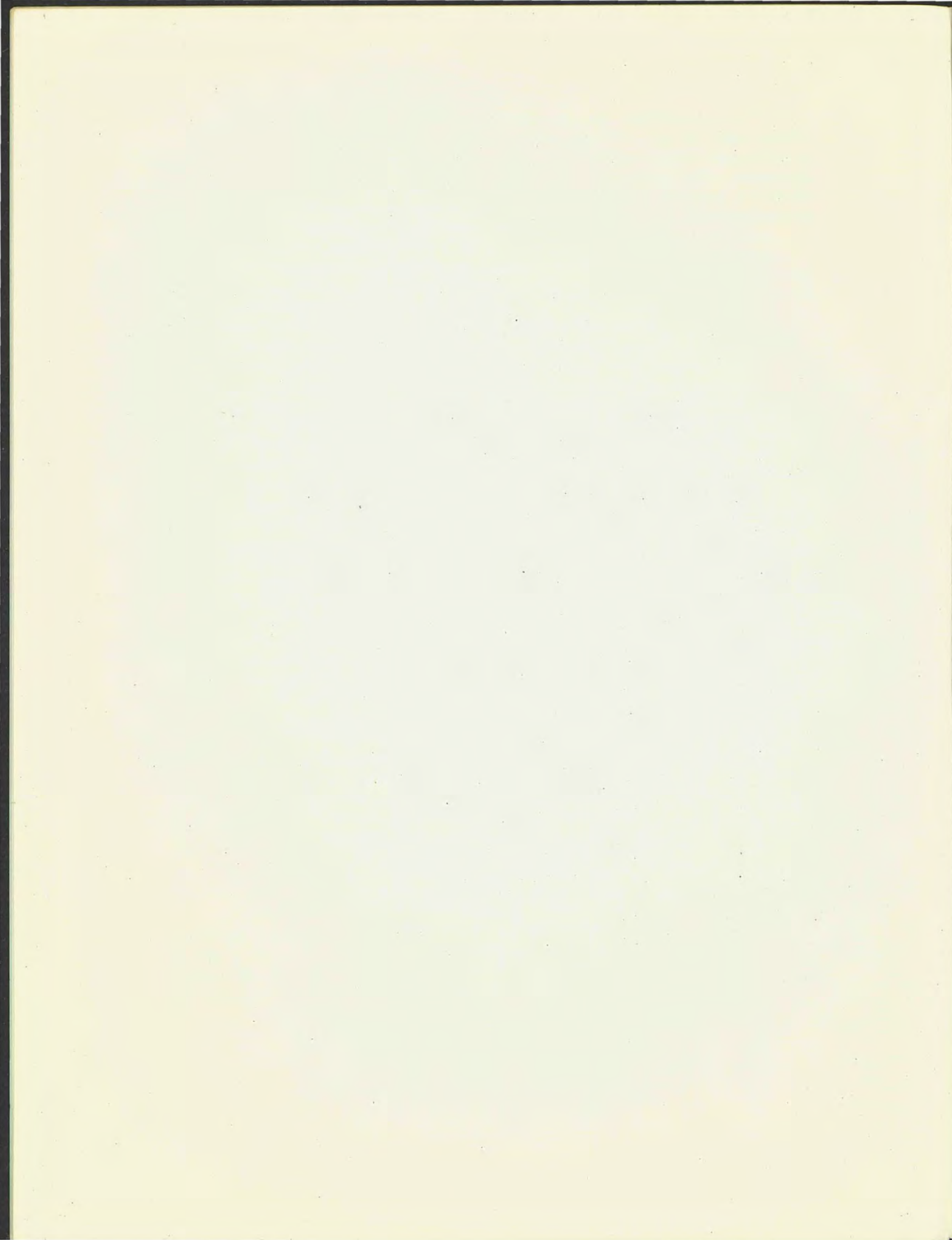
In ordering these reports, use the entire number citation (e.g., K717.0414-36/30, 500-354). Generally, a printed copy will be forwarded on temporary loan. However, in some instances, only microfilm is available. In all cases, microfilm can be made available permanently for a modest fee.

Note also that on 15 May 1977, the administrative marking AFEO will no longer be valid unless extended by the originator or higher authority.

In addition to the published reports and the supporting documents listed in this guide, AFSHRC maintains the Air Force unit histories and their supporting documents, the Air Force oral history collection, the Air Force end-of-tour report files, the CORONA HARVEST reports and their supporting documents, the CHECO microfilm, plus a wide variety and a vast amount of other materials concerning Air Force activities.
