Inside base camp fd medical equipment, including complete rucksack, plasma, intravenous feeding device, penicillin, surgical dressing, rubber gloves, sheets, antibiotics, nurses gear, a recovery ward, (15 to 20 people), cooking hootch, 1 latrine, also fd 2 graves with male bodies, estimated 2 weeks old.

Also found trap (2) graves with one (1) male body in each. B Co: moved to FSB Debbie to secure FSB. C Co conducted CA fr FSB Debbie to B- 720355 to conduct a search and clear operation. D Co continued pacification of trap hamlets and security of Engr Pass. 1 st plt of D Co with PF's search and clear operation at B- 830356 1 and 105 rd and M-79 rds set up as booby trap. Both booby traps blown in place. CP and 2nd plt D Co at B- 832332 took 20 to 30 rds of AK fire exact loc unknown, negative cas. Recon (-) with 1st AF Co 108 conducted CA fr FSB Debbie to B- 322270 and B- 322264 to check on intell report of tunnel with VC/NVA and at vic B- 925273, detained 14 personnel, 4 confirmed VC according to Village Chief and 2 VCS.
