Upon completion of this duty, each of the above named students will return to Champaign, Illinois. The Finance Department will pay each of the above named students five cents (5¢) per mile for the return journey in advance of the actual performance of said travel, which is chargeable to procurement authority FD 376 P 7-06 A 1605-12. The travel directed is necessary in the Military Service.
