
Dear Gen. Knowles:

You are invited to a mock-up inspection of the AAPC (Aerial Armored Personnel Carrier) at Sikorsky Aircraft in Stratford, Connecticut, on Friday, September 12, 1969. This mock-up also includes a full scale mock-up of the ABC rotorhead, controls, and an actual rotor blade which would have equivalent invulnerability against small arms fire as would the completely armored fuselage.

The present mock-up has been constructed of aluminum, prior to its finally being duplicated in DPSA (Dual Purpose Steel Armor), under contract with AMMRC, Watertown, Massachusetts.

We hope it will be possible for your command to be represented to review this new and interesting concept of armored air mobility.
