MEMORANDUM FOR: EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT AND SENIOR AIDE TO CHAIRMAN, JOINT CHIEFS OF STAFF

SUBJECT: Involuntary Release of Retirement Eligible Personnel

1. Reference is made to memorandum, DAPE-ZX, 18 November 1971, subject as above, which informed you of subject program and that SFC James M. Whigam, enlisted aide to Admiral Moorer, and SFC Henry L. Bray, enlisted aide to LTG Knowles, are subject to involuntary release.

2. Detailed guidance concerning this program was forwarded to your office in Department of the Army letter, DAAG-PSS-R (M) (29 November 1971), 3 December 1971, Involuntary Release of Retirement Eligible Enlisted Personnel. As stated in the letter, Sergeants First Class Whigam and Bray may be retained until 30 June 1972 if it is desired by either yourself or the enlisted members concerned. The April and February 1972 dates reflected in referenced memorandum represent those points in time in which Sergeants Whigam and Bray are eligible for maximum retirement benefits. The intent should not have been that Sergeants Whigam and Bray be separated on those respective dates, but that they may elect to retire on any convenient date, subject to their own personal and family considerations, on or before 30 June 1972.
