As President of TET 68, Inc., a Virginia based non-profit organization, I have been receiving your Center's newsletters for many years. I am currently Secretary of the Virginia War Memorial Foundation and a Vietnam veteran.

By separate boxes, I am giving the Archives copies of congressional testimony by Marine Private Robert "Bobby" Garwood from January, 1992 before the Senate Select Committee on POWs. Additionally, there are several indexes from the National Archives showing what documents are in various boxes. I had planned to write a book about David Harker, Lynchburg, VA, who was held with Garwood but decided I am no writer. I may have second thoughts when I consider some of the dribble I have read over the past 20 years about Vietnam!
