I was so excited to learn that you will be attending this year's TET '68 weekend in Richmond, Virginia on February 3rd and 4th that I phoned Marty donohue at his work to tell him once I'd gotten off the phone with you.

You will be joining a long list of distinguished Vietnam veterans - Gen. Westmoreland, Navy CPT Rick Hauck, USAF Col. Fred Cherry, Seabee's Admiral Marschal, MOH recipients, and just plain soldiers, airmen, women, and sailors - who have taken their time to attend TET '68. I enclose a program of events from 1990 to illustrate what it is we do. People who attend usually number around 300-350 and we have a good group of repeaters.
