Point of View: Duties and Responsibilities of the Vietnamese regarding their National Frontiers and Interests

In order to make up history, to make a good turn with the times, nothing would be more valuable than the lessons of blood and tears gotten from history. Knowing to the end of the fact, understanding profoundly to the source of the matter, knowing how to proceed the strategy, we will be the winners for sure.

The Satan Hanoi Politburo could not distinguish the frontier between Politics, Economics, Culture. The discourse of Le Duc Anh to the French delegation obviously showed. The narrow knowledge of the Vietnamese Communist Party, how could they be far-sighted for planning strategy for the race of Viets who have just experienced a long war?

The Vietnamese Communist envoys were thrown with tomatoes, rotten eggs, and were driven away wherever they can. What a shame for the Viets who descend from the same race but shout at each other with dirty words in front of the foreigners!

Proclamation of The Revolutionary Front For The Restoration of Vietnam:

A Forty-Year Path: It Is the Path of Cruelty and Crime that the United States Gave to Vietnam, to the Nation of Vietnam!

From the ancient time up to now, all kinds of creature being discontented will try make themselves clear. When all creatures being oppressed must shout out as a rule. Vietnamese people feel very sad when wondering about acting and experience but, no, positively no, for nothing can be more perfect than beauty, and beauty come from the heart and speech.

These words are not the "White Paper", the "Accusation", but they are really the explaining words for the Vietnamese people in or out of the country to wake up themselves by the facts of history worthy of our thoughts and experimentations.

Never speak of one person out of the whole group, because that will cause discomfort for many people. We must distinguish the greater part of the American people— 250 million people—who are good natured ones, from the minority of filthy American representatives. So for the good people, let them have understanding on our plain words that might hurt their feelings, please forgive us.

• Geneva Agreement (July 20, 1954)

The Geneva Agreement was set up on July 20, 1954 after the French's defeat at the Dien Bien Phu Battle. It divided VN into two parts along the river of Ben Hai (17th Parallel). The North belonged to the Communist; the South was a free state. This Agreement was seconded by 14 countries, and according to the Agreement, Vietnamese people had the right to choose either the North or the South to live in. At that time, Le Quang Luat one of the leaders of the Duy Dan Party was the Representative of the North Government, along with Priest Mai Ngoc Khue, Priest Hoang Quynh, with the wholehearted assistance from the French; they requested the Geneva International Committee to go to the distant regions such as Thanh Hoa, Nghe An, Ha Tinh, Quang Binh and many other places to communicate the spirit of the Agreement. It resulted the wave of 800,000 emigrants from the North into the South including various minorities: Muong, Man, Meo, Tho, Thai. These people had encountered lots of hardships in escaping, crossing the sea to Hanoi, Hai Phong, trying to avoid the terrible plot of impeding of the North Communists.

Typically, we can talk about the two cases of Quynh Luu and Ba Lang, tens of thousand had died in the open sea.

Hanoi was given 100 days and Hai Phong 300 days to leave for the South. People were living in worry, anxiety about the assassinations, mine explosions, grenade lancing to kill the Nationalists. But Mr. Le Quang Luat, Priests Mai Ngoc Khue and Hoang Quynh, and the Buddhist officials were protected by the French who conducted patrols and watchers in all streets, so the withdrawal from the North in spite of thousands of difficulties, had been safe, and the blood-thirsty Northerners could not realize the bizarre actions.

• Just Cause will win the Deviousness

That was the iron-like belief of the departees to the South, with bitterness they left their North homeland, tears hung over their eyes, they could not even pay visits to their ancestors' resting places because of the emergency situation. The Geneva Agreement stipulated the temporary splitting but the reunification would be realized by voting after two years.

The seminars between the French scholars and the distinguished persons brought forth the belief that the cruelty of the North Communists would be exposed to light: How they destroyed religions and how they had killed members of all Nationalist Parties and these was known by the North people, especially they (VC) based on the slogan: "Demolition for Resistance", they destroyed, burned down the cities such as in case of Nam Dinh,

only the yarn-elastic mills area was spared of Hanoi, the area down the river was devastated; the cities of Ninh Binh, Thanh Hoa, Tay Do, the old citadel of the Le Dynasty were all torn down, none of the piece of brick being left over; even the shrines, pagodas of the nation of Viets were also demolished.

The Communists of the North used the slogan: "Demolition for Resistance" in the view of impoverishing the people, so nobody could have any property. The Viets were good-natured, living with a water buffalo and a piece of land, hardly there were people to be called "capitalist", even the former King Bao Dai, he even had no assets of one million dollars. *Demolition for Resistance* was known as a cruel pretext.

Not yet taking over the North, the North Communists slaughter already moved the policy "fighting and denouncing the landlords", and they had killed more than 400 thousand people that they called: "cruel officials, filthy landlords". The relatives of these people such as wives and children committed suicide, the number came up, at least, 100 thousand people (see *Academic Intelligentsia, Religions*, document on the *Fighting and Denouncing*. Hoang Van Hoan, a former member of the Politburo escaping to China).

After the operation of "Fighting and Denouncing", the prisons held more than 100 thousand people to be brain-washed; the public-influencing person were deported to special and remote zones, and was not allowed to contact with human-beings. These people told the prisoners from the South: "We had hoped you would liberate us. Oh boy! never had we doubted that after 20 years of hardships, we again had to gather every potatoes to support you! So, please try to survive for there will be a day you could bring light back to our country."

From the North to the South, all kinds of religions, parties were equally destroyed.

• Who purported to go at war? Who broke the Geneva Agreement? Who turned down the General Election? — May we speak out? It was the United States.

Now, may Van Thang raise a question with the U.S. The U.S. did not sign the Geneva Agreement. Secretary of State Foster Dulles promised (to the French) to bomb Dien Bien Phu; the U.S. had kicked the French out the Indochina!

Late President Ngo Dinh Diem did not sign any treaty to invite the Americans into Vietnam. Why the presence of the Americans in Vietnam?

Mr. Bedel Smith (CIA Director) was present at Geneva, why didn't he sign the Agreement? Please remember: according to the international laws, every treaty must observe the juridical power, and economical laws of that particular country.

Well, during 21 years, accidents was caused by the American soldiers in Vietnam, were they been recorded and brought to courts?

Many American officers married Vietnamese girls, then left them behind with their innocent child after the war. Is this a humanity?

The Americans come to Vietnam, but the Vietnam laws could not be applied to them, was that a good idea?

Of the trade, why were there Post-Exchanges (P.X.) for U.S. Armed Forces, Korea, Thailand, New Zealand, Australia, but none for Vietnamese Armed Forces?

The Vietnamese Presidents, Mr. Ngo Dinh Diem, Duong Van Minh Nguyen Van Thieu, did anyone of them sign the agreement for foreign country armies to come over Vietnam to make war? So, the foreign armies were bought into Vietnam by U.S.A. and

we would like to ask the U.S. government let us know the agreement and what can the foreign soldiers deserve if they fought for US. Was that the law solely made by U.S.A.?

• **The South-North General Election. The South would be the winner**

The Communists were so cruel.
About 1,000,000 refugees were against Communist. Strength and US dollars (1955-1956) were enormous. The International Committee was created for supervision. Then, if U.S. had had the real intention to help the South, the South would have won the General Election (1956).

• **The U.S. Policy**

The US planned to encircle Soviet Union and Red China with the stratagem "Domino" using Cambodia, Laos and the other Southeast Asia countries as advance posts. So, the Geneva Agreement must be demolished for the General Election not to be realized. So the war maker was not the South Government.

• **The Scheme for the Religion of Cao Dai**

The Cao Dai's kingdom was located in Tay Ninh, Ba Den Mountain and Suoi Da. Most of the Cao Dai Congregation live as monks, all of them were vegetarian and obey their laws, practicing ceremonies in a solemn way. Cao Dai uses life to protect the Religion (Way); and uses the religion to cultivate humans. People there conducted a very peaceful lives.

General Trinh Minh The had long experienced living in the forest with his revolutionary army in friendship; his wife and children lived in a cottage. His personality and talent in leadership created fear in the Communist Party. The people of the South equally paid him homage. Why was General Trinh Minh The killed?

Was it because of the sweet negotiation with Reverend Supreme leader Pham Cong Tac: standing unified in a National Front against the North Communists. Was this suggestion from the U.S. delegation?

Believed in the words of Lansdale (CIA), General The returned to Saigon, and was shot at the "Y" Bridge. The rumor was spread out that the French killed General The because General The had been anti-French. President Diem cried to unconsciousness. Some people smiled, saying that his tears were the crocodile's tears! No, President Diem never had him shot. He needed General The, really needed General The at that historic phase.

One question was raised: Why after the death of General The, his army was totally torn? Why Reverend Pham Cong Tac must flee to abroad and died in Cambodia?

• **How about the United States Cheat played on Hoa Hao Buddhism?**

Hoa Hao Buddhism included 2 million followers living in Chau Doc, Ha Tien, Long Xuyen, Sa Dec, Rach Gia, Can Tho. Viet Cong could not do any trick. Generals Le Quang Vinh, Nguyen Giac Ngo defeated them to the last one.

General Le Quang Vinh, alias Ba Cut, had cut one of his fingers off to swear his iron faith to his religion. Well, spy Lansdale tried many times to cajole him. Finally Lansdale developed a scheme for Vice-President Nguyen Ngoc Tho to talk with General Le Quang Vinh on behalf of the nation. So, Ba Cut had agreed and then was arrested and executed at Can Tho. General Le Quang Vinh stated at the court: "I have spent my life making revolution against foreigners, destroying wicked Viet Cong, I don't even have piastre in my pocket. I have nothing to declare." Years after, Vice-President Nguyen Ngoc Tho had complained to be duped by U.S.A. along with the Association of South Schools. History will put this fact to light.

From that time on, people living there become torn apart from each other. Let U.S. answer the question.

The two zones, the west of Hoa Hao, the east of Cao Dai, had good relations with Cambodia. If these two zones existed, Viet Cong would have never had Cambodia as a base to conquer the South.

Still, spy Lansdale wrote books naming himself as National Advisor for President Diem; a National Advisor was the King's Master. It was a big arrogance; a little Lansdale could be a master to the Head of the Nation of Viet? A question is: Would the Government of Bill Clinton accept the mistakes and say apology to Cao Dai and Hoa Hao? And Clinton, must he restore the honor of Generals The and Vinh?

• **The barbarous murder of late President Ngo Dinh Diem and Advisor Ngo Dinh Nhu**

The land of South Vietnam from Ca Mau to Ben Hai was rehabilitated. Foreign visitors expressed their feelings of admiration. On virtue, President Ngo Dinh Diem was a person of benevolence and valor, but he was only an administrator but not a resourceful politician. Mr. Ngo Dinh Nhu was intelligent and conservative, but he was better at foreign culture than his country's romantic tastes!

They were accused of their familial nepotism. But isn't it the scheme of the U.S.? The U.S. needed the South of VN as an access to Asia, so American newspapers exclusively praised Mr. Ngo Dinh Diem as an outstanding leader in Asia! In 1956, Vice President Richard Nixon stated during his trip to VN: "The American frontier stretches to the 17th Parallel"; what did he mean? Mr. Diem visited the U.S. and was seated with President Eisenhower, banners and flags were seen everywhere, speeches were launched at Congress. Friendship had never been so close!

• **The Plot changed according to the time**

Cabot Lodge, U.S. Ambassador, failed in persuading Ngo Dinh Diem to follow the U.S. strategy, so a filthy Coup d'Etat was made up to overthrow President Diem.

Cabot Lodge himself gave orders to the Generals: *I don't want prisoners, I only want corpses!* General Le Van Kim being known as a partisan to the French, having drinks with General Mai Huu Xuan at that late night, had said: *You have done a deed that never happened in history.* (General Xuan had revealed this to several close persons.)

If Cabot Lodge had not ordered, how could has men have dared to tie Mr. Diem and Mr. Nhu's arms behind their backs in the armored tank, and thrust them with several stabs on their heads, throats and bodies! Nothing would be more barbarous than stabbing an alive person then shooting them to death. General

Kim's words were really words of conscience.

Mr. Diem and Mr. Nhu were Christians. Did they call out the most distinguished names of Jesus Christ and Maria when each stab was driven into their bodies?

Helas! Honor of the race and conscience of country-to-country relationship!

It was true that Cabot Lodge had received the orders of the White House. Mr. Ngo Dinh Can, a highest government representative in the central of VN, had gotten into the U.S. Consulate for asylum, but why was he driven out? and then afterward, he was executed. Whose order was it? Isn't it from Cabot Lodge?

Why Thich Tri Quang (Communist monk) was allowed to get asylum in the US embassy in Saigon, and in order to polish Thich Tri Quang, U.S. newspaper exaggerated: "*Thich Tri Quang was shaking the U.S.*" What a magic!

On this very day of Coup d'Etat, millions of photographs of Madam Ngo Dinh Nhu seen naked, were given out and millions of common people eagerly set off to see cellars of acid in the President's House and in the zoo P40 for dissolving human bodies. No acid cellars were found. Let the U.S. give an answer. Madam Ngo Dinh Nhu planned to write a memoir, then her daughter was killed in a car crash. Whoa?

• **Pain and Sorrow make man be thinking**

So many above pain and sorrow made priest Khai and his group, being positively anti-communist members, were determined to adhere to the solution of Neutralism denying the presence of Americans in VN. The group of Lien Truong (the League of Schools, group of South intellectuals) was broken up, typically was the case of Mr. Ly Chanh Trung who wrote blaming-U.S. articles; even Father Cao Van Luan must do the same, too.

During four scores of years under the French domination, a decade in war with the French, any of the governments of the time also included all of the religions and parties exclusively.

During 21 years when Americans dominating over the South of VN, from Mr. Diem's time to the Military's Government, all governing stages of Nguyen Van Thieu were from military; was there any of religions or parties to be allowed to take part of? If yes, they were only puppets!

To identify this policy, Cabot Lodge showed his arrogance in stating: "*Vietnamese Parties? Kind of rags!*" and General Taylor had haughtily made some statements to Vietnamese Generals, please ask former General Nguyen Khanh for he said several times that he still kept the tapes!

The group under the title "*The Ngo Dinh Diem's Spirit*" was founded in Europe, U.S.A., Australia and Canada, for Mr. Ngo Dinh Diem's virtuous life?

Now, *Van Thang* may introduce this proposal: Vietnamese Refugee Immigrants shall have a day off (without being paid) in memory of the day when President Ngo Dinh Diem launched his speech at the U.S. Congress, and the U.S. Congress shall organize a memorial day for Mr. Diem and Mr. Nhu's souls. For the U.S.-South VN friendship to be re-connected, is this a reasonable proposal? Hope for the U.S.'s favorable response!

- November 1, 1963 was the Buddhist Revolutionary Day, the Coup d'Etat or the Authority manifestation?

- How could it be the Buddhist Revolution when no Buddhist member was in the government?

- Coup d'Etat? Much more ironical it was for the generals had to make a lot of running back and forth to look for Mr. Tran Trung Dung (nephew-in-law of Mr. Diem) to write the Constitutional Declaration.

- What a heart breaking truth! It was coming from the violence with guns starting from Duong Van Minh, Nguyen Khanh, the Military Committee down to Nguyen Van Thieu. The fact turned out the ways of manifesting Authorities: *I did all and all came from Me, by Me who managed purposely!*

• **Upheaval from strategy**

All kinds of upheaval from the Buddhist Revolution were only political maneuvers in view to eliminate the pro-France generals, that was why Nguyen Khanh proceeded the "Political Adjustment" calling this as a means to eliminating the Neutrals, etc...

Only an average awareness could help to recognize immediately that: Communist Monk Tri Quang along with other Bright Red Monks went on dispute with violence against Vietnam Quoc Tu (VN National Pagoda) of Monk Thich Tam Chau, Tam Giac, Duc Nghiep; Blood had shed many times for occupying the National Pagoda; Threats had been used for the National Pagoda to stay still, if not..., etc... Tri Quang's group went on hunger strike, displayed Buddhist altars on the streets, and then Nguyen Cao Ky had them cleared away by bull-dozer!

Why could such tragic events between the two religions: Buddhism and Catholicism, happened right in the sacred areas? Because CIA scattered the news that Buddhists had destroyed the church in this area, and the Christians had put down the pagoda in that area. In history, Buddhism and Catholicism had lived in common, never had the bloodshed between Catholicism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Buddhist teachings on Benevolence, Self-Denial have been incorporated in the Vietnamese, Confucius's Ritual and Music have been exclusive of Vietnamese fashion. Owing to the culture of knowledge and valor, the Vietnamese people have served their country for uncountable times starting with the dynasty of Ngo, Dinh, Le, Ly, Tran... however, the war cloak of Red color was put on the body of Buddha!

Christianity has got a very strict hierarchy, the followers keep their iron faith to God and Maria. Reverend Mai Ngoc Khue, a brave and intelligent gentleman, the leader-in-chief of Tan Sa Chau, had organized a demonstration in front of the Joint General Staff Headquarters for the sake of his religion, as a result, 8 persons were killed, lots of others injured. Later, Reverend Khue was strangled, died naked, his body was terribly bruised, covered with female underwears of his face near the Tan Sa Chau Church, this fact would explain: this guy was killed on jealousy cause—dealing with girls. Rumor spread out noisily, at the funeral, grenades and mines were seen everywhere, then people hastily ran away. Many of these people still living oversea are witnesses.

• **The crafty scheme of the trick**

Helas, Buddhism must be so mean, Chistianity must be so base,

then Protestantism could be introduced into Vietnam with easiness, and Protestantism would be the wind shields for spies' actions in the long run. No wonder why just in one decade, Protestant churches had been built everywhere with the amount of followers came up to 700,000!

A miracle indeed, never had there been a religion that could spread so fast, so powerfully.

• **The trial of Pastor Nguyen Van Tong**

Pastor Nguyen Van Tong who being from Sa Dec, intelligent, agile, was the Chaplain General of Protestantism and also the leader General of Protestantism Churches; a little caution would help to understand that he had been set up by CIA. Mr. Tong had a regiment of secret well-trained rangers commanded by his two sons who were Nguyen Dong A and Nguyen A Dong. One of them died, some days after being released by Viet Cong. The other is still in prison now. Dr. Rev. Tran Hoc Hieu expressed his high praise to Mr. Tong, for, based on several sources of reliable news, Mr. Tong had bravely proved in front of the Court. This was a heroic act. Many Protestant officers very close to Mr. Tong, didn't they know about that fact?

The day that the Paris Agreement was signed for preparing the turning over of the South Vietnam to the North Communists, was also the day Mr. Tong terminated his role, and Tong could not be left behind in Vietnam, but he could also not be brought to the U.S. for the scheme would be revealed, so who had put poison in the mouth of the Pastor Tong? He died, his face turned as black as tar from the forehead to the throat, a lot of people eyewitnessed at the moment his corpse was put into the coffin; many of them are still in life.

• **Other Court Cases**

Nguyen Bao Toan, Vu Tam Anh were put into sacks to drop into the river. Vu Duc Dien, director-general of the Reconstruction Services was empoisoned. The highly-reliable gentleman able to reunite people, such as Mr. Tran Van Van, Dr. Le Minh Tri who was determined to put reform on education; Dr. Nguyen Van Bong, the great credit of the students; Dr. Tu Chung, a sharp writer of the Chinh Luan newspaper and Viet Chien; he was tasked for a secret mission. All of them were assassinated by Viet Cong; too full of evidence!

• **The perfect turning-over of the South Vietnam**

Paris Agreement was negotiated on deals after deals; the Minister of the Premier's Ministry along with the North VN Generals and Bui Tin, were present at the moment when each US unit withdrew from the South VN. They stayed in what hotels, what villas, please ask Col. Bui Tin, a beloved son of Vietnamese traitor Bui Bang Doan.

- The casualty of the 2nd Corps withdrawal from Phu Bon to Phu Yen, was well known by the US.

- The Hai Van pass was blocked, no way for people and military men could move; orders were now for staying defending, now for withdrawal. General Ngo Quang Truong, a valiant general of soldiers-as- brothers-spirit was thrown lying on the shore, was that the strategy of General Truong? Let General Truong answer this question to the 1st Corps.

- The bases of Subic and Guam had been prepared with tents, canvas for 7 months in advance. April 30, 1975 was the ending day, the vessels carrying Vietnamese soldiers and common people kept moving back and forth then landed back on Vietnam's land, without sailing to Guam. Nobody knew why?

- The 18th Division was tattered in Long Khanh; Viet Cong advanced straight to Route #5 to take over the province of Ba Ria, then no way to travel to Vung Tau.

- An amount of people could leave VN for being friends of Vietnamese women married to Americans, and of the girls serving in bars. Some of Nungs could reach Vung Tau in their own fishing boats; The people from Phuoc Tinh, Ben Da sailing to open seas were rescued; more fortunate were some Navy's men and some hundreds of parachutist soldiers who could avoid dangers.

After taking account of the number of people that was not enough for the need, US Navy ships headed to Phu Quoc to get 7 thousand people more for meeting the numbered required for refugees criteria.

- Frequent Wind plan came to its end, Polgar was still staying with girls. American soldiers beat on the Viet's heads with their guns on the last helicopters leaving VN. Please ask Polgar, CIA's full-power officer. Former President Gerald Ford announced: "*A page of history has passed.*" When Vietnam's Generals got into US ships, echelons, banners, badges were ripped off and thrown to the sea. No ceremony had been done to bid farewell to the flag!

• **The Passed Page of History**

- The FULRO's case was a scheme of the US "Divion for easy administration", that incited FULRO soldiers to kill Vietnamese officers and servicemen. Please the U.S.'s Press make publicity of this fact.

- The My Lai's case, a barbarous crime, murder of more than 300 people including babies just born. Would the U.S. take care of compensation?

- Mac Coin, who were you so as you could know the trafficking network of morphine, opium from the time when Mr. Diem to Thieu, Ky?

- Vietnam's Armed Forces: how heroic were their fightings, was there any unit that surrendered to the enemies? Why the U.S. Press blackened them as cowards?

- Before April 30, 1975, there were no more than 20,000 girls serving in the bars, the U.S. Congress stated: "*Saigon was the nest of prostitutes*", now millions of prostitutes in Saigon. Why no comment on that fact from the U.S.?

- Barbarous men of the North Communist Party coming to the South VN, made collective killings of more than 2 million people, why nothing related on the U.S. newspapers?

- More than one million boatmen died at open sea. The U.S. Press did not tell anything about that.

- Military officers, government officials of the South VN as described on the French Press: "*Now there were 32,000 political prisoners of war in VN, 300,000 had died in re-education camps.*" Why no statement had been seen on U.S. papers?

— How ironical it is with the term "Embargo." In 1993 when the "Embargo law" had not been lifted, the US medicines of about 300,000,000 dollars were already exported to Vietnam. This fact was reported every day to the U.S. Congress. What was that?

— U.S. companies moved into Vietnam; establishing banks, telephone facilities, airlines; What with embargo?

• About the assassination of Ambassador Tran Van Chuong

The filthy court case: the assassination crime was attributed to lawyer Tran Van Khiem.

Why must "they" assassinate Mr. and Mrs. Tran Van Chuong? Because Mr. Chuong had written about the secrets in his memoir written in French. He wrote about the cause of the death of President Diem and his son-in-law, Mr. Ngo Dinh Nhu. Mr. Chuong wrote about the plot of U.S. in Vietnam and the reasons that made U.S. destroy the Geneva Agreement and the General Election. "They" killed Mr. and Mrs. Chuong, then attributed the crime to the unique son of Mr. and Mrs. Chuong, lawyer Tran Van Khiem.

In oriental history, the tragedy of "killing parents" was never happened, except the case: Vo Thai Hau (China) and Tu Hi Thai Hau compelled their sons to kill themselves. Perhaps, in the history of the accident as well as the orient, never was there a son who killed his mother. That was because of the nature of mankind. Perhaps, there was an impertinent child who killed his father during his loss of control as usually occurs in U.S.A. But in orient, there was not such an inhuman act. Lawyer Khiem was well educated from both cultures: Vietnam and France. The family of Tran's was a family of good background. Khiem was known as a haughty person, a little unsocial, a little boastful, and "too much French," but he was piteous, well-behaved, respectful to his parents and he deeply respected his mother. Suppose Khiem had the intention of killing his parents, he would not act so openly, and so stupidly. Mr. and Mrs. Chuong had been killed and the culture and ethics of Vietnam had been blackened.

Lawyer Khiem could find many ways to kill his parents, for instance, he could poisons. It was impossible for Khiem to strangle two people at the same time while Khiem's wife and children slept upstairs. Mrs. Khiem was a French woman. How could she stay quiet for her husband to kill his parents just for a will? Nobody believed that. The assets of Mr. and Mrs. Chuong were not worthy for Khiem to commit killing. Moreover, Khiem was Mr. and Mrs. Chuong's unique son, he would be the principal heir to the property.

During the ending period of life, Mr. Chuong's had nothing to take care of, his wife took care of every household work. Mrs. Chuong indulged Khiem from his childhood, to the age of 60, when Khiem was attributed the crime of "killing parents."

Khiem was said: Mad! Mad, how could he practice lawyer's work? Mad, how he could continue working until the vacation when he took his wife and children over U.S. to see his parent, then he was attributed to the crime "killing parents"? Moreover, according to psychology, a mad man could have no capacity to do something purposely, especially to kill his parents intentionally. The evidence was that after being held in a psychiatric clinic for some years, now he had returned to France, though with his mind troubled and hurt by the attribution of "killing parents", he stayed awake, conscious, far away from being a mad man.

In short, obviously Khiem had never killed his parents. He is now well-alert; he is able to talk clearly about the savage crime put upon his head. Obviously, Mr. and Mrs. Chuong had been killed for many objectives: to do away with the two utmost important witnesses who knew about the scheme of U.S. since the Geneva Agreement (1954) to the plot of killing the brothers of Ngo and the plan to bring armies into Vietnam, as well as the conspiracy of selling the South of Vietnam squarely to Viet Cong. The memory of late Ambassador Tran was a historic proof U.S. needed to put to zero!

While still in life, Mr. Chuong revealed his confidence to some people: "They" threatened him, and used pressure on him for not to publish his memoir at that time. But he kept writing it. He already finished the important chapters; Mr. Khiem, on the occasion of his vacation, took his wife and children over US to see his parents, Khiem planned to bring the memoir to France for printing with safety, then Mr. and Mrs. Chuong were strangled and beaten to death; the crime was attributed to their unique son. The news of Mr. and Mrs. Chuong was killed by their son and was put on the headlines of the Washington Post, and Washington Time.

This news broke out as a great turmoil in Washington, DC; in the diplomatic milieu and the US high society. This was also a way to soil the honor of the nation of Viet. Killing parents happens in barbarous countries. The Washington Post, and many other U.S. newspapers wrote several times about the leaders' society and the high class of the South of Vietnam. There was no way more mean and savage than the way of vilifying the South of Vietnam, particularly speaking, and the constitutional culture of Vietnam generally speaking.

No argument could corroborate the villainy, the barbarism in the case of murdering Mr. and Mrs. Chuong, then the crime was put on Mr. Khiem, so as to accomplished several mean aims at one time!

• Who assassinated reporter Le Triet? What barbarism!

Le Triet was born in 1929, in Thanh Hoa, descending from the family of Han Lam. He was a revolutionist in Thanh Hoa. His father was buried alive, his uncles and brothers were killed by Vietnamese Communists, his son-in-law, the Marine Bugade Commander, died in the Communist prison. His wife was Mrs. Dane Tran Hi Toyed, 52 years old. Both husband and wife were assassinated when they came home from a party at Fairfax (Virginia) on the Saturday night of September 22, 1990 at 11 P.M.

According to the observation of the crime expert, the murder must be a fanatic rather than a professional-hire murder.

Mr. Dinh Tu Thuc wrote: Le Triet was not a professional reporter, but he fought as a soldier, with his pen as a weapon, he had swung his pen as a general on the battle field, attacking on

the left, on the right, fighting without halt, restlessly for all 13 years.

Reporter Chadwich depicted: Le Triet was a famous Vietnamese of a Vietnamese magazine best sold at the time. Chadwick stated "when the assassination occurred, it was thought that he was dead of a political murder".

Mr. Nguyen Viet, in VNTP magazine wrote: The death of Le Triet and his wife had effect on man's conscience, not conscience of Vietnamese people, but of different nations in the world. A kind of death deeply sorrowful and cutting made many people awakened. It could make the righteous and the evil face to each other, and hence, there might be a common denominator for them.

People usually think that only in distance countries there would be such a way of living! See, the victims were living right in a country that most civilized and wealthiest of the world! What a puzzle?!

A question should be raised: What force, what invisible hands keep controlling that kind of direction and action?

Hundred of pens of Vietnamese people all over the world have expressed their pain and sorrow, with so many words that 11 Van Thang newspapers could not contain to the full.

Vietnamese people considered as the case of Le Triet as a cruel one, but with American strategy, Le Triet and his wife must die, regardless of any price because Le Triet had known too much when he still was a staff member of the Eagle Operation. Moving into U.S., Le Triet and his wife had got to work for daily bread, but his soul and mind was always occupied with his country's debt and his family revenge, they must get rid of the Communist Party to save the people. His pen was worth as a division of armed forces against communists.

Times have changed, American minds have changed, too. In 1985 Soviet Union was reformed with perestroika, glasnost: it was a mess of confusion. Vietnamese Communists made corruption, confiscation, labor export for money. This was time for us (Americans) to take advantage of this issue. Therefore, the clan of Kissinger, Polgar, Colby, made out a plan: The South of Vietnam full of corruption, drugs, prostitution; the Vietnam Armed Forces of cowardice, we (Americans) have liquidated totally. Le Triet knows a lot of our stratagem, would write out our godly plan! In 1990, tens of thousand cadres from Hanoi left for U.S., infiltrating the religions, political parties, associations, communities, newspapers. Mr. and Mrs. Le Triet died with a funeral, that was their blessing instead, they must have been put to death at the open sea for sharks! This blessing should be asked with the clan of Kissinger.

Let's call Le Triet blankly as a hero and dedicate him this verse: *Though your body was gone your name will be brightly shone forever.*

• The present-day lesson

General Hoang Co Minh was the most patriot. His Unified National Front For Liberation of Vietnam was set up and bright polished with all means: CBS, etc... 10,000 resistant soldiers, grand gathering at Washington DC, Houston, California, police cars escorting; fighting compounds; 30,000 prisoners captured... — Did the Party's Central Committee and the Congress raise this question with the Politburo and the people?

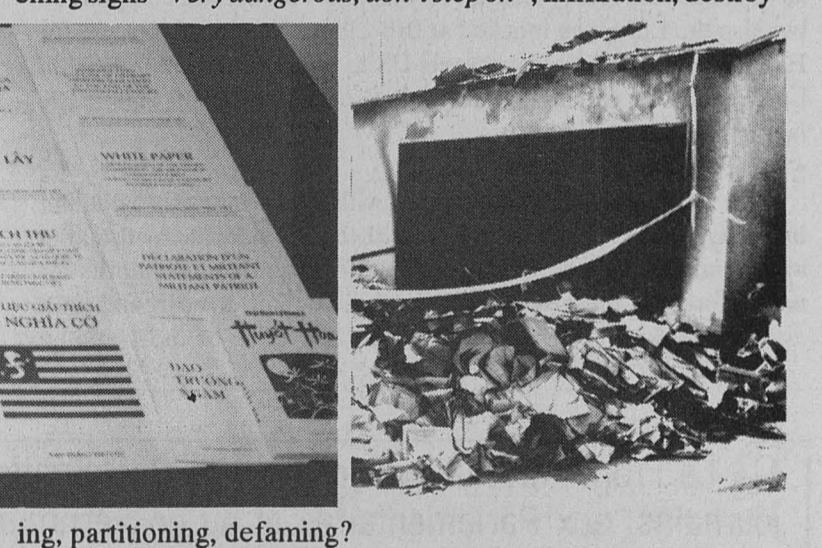
— The remainder of 50,000 cadres—half American half Vietnamese—is there a need to set up the camp to reform then their behaviors?

—France has thousands of persons who speak, write Vietnamese fluently. Russia has at least two thousand people good at Vietnamese. The U.S. certainly have more than that for an additional amount of pastors preaching Protestantism.

—Lots of writing about devine prophecy, horoscope, palmistry, foretelling are seen in libraries, bookstores. Americans will say "good luck" in greetings. Does it come from social life or is it inspired by spiritual life? Horoscope and advertisements of foretelling are seen in almost American newspapers. So, *The Prophecy of Princess Lieu Hanh* (printed in *Van Thang* #5) being a hundred years old, can it be deemed as accurate?

—*Trang Trinh's Prophecy* of 400 years ago, printed on the *Van Thang* #9 and #10, has revealed explicitly the names of Ly Dong A and Le Tu Vinh, is this event accurate? Many publications of Trang Trinh's prophecy are seen in American libraries, and why must Hanoi create distortion?
