VVMF Welcome Center

The Welcome center will operate from 7a.m.-11p.m. Sat., Nov. 7 - Tues., Nov. 10 and 7a.m.-1p.m. Wed., Nov. 11.

Volunteers are needed for 4 hour shifts from 7a.m.-11a.m., 11a.m.-3p.m., 3p.m.-7p.m., and 7p.m.-11p.m. Responsibilities include orienting people to the Mall area, distributing VVMF literature, and answering general questions about activities.

Reading the Names and Honor Guard:
