MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Australian OH-58A Training

Summary: a. MAJ Harden, CO 161 Recce Flt AFV, informed this headquarters that the Australians were desirous of changing the amount of training time spent with the 5th Avn Det for their EM, postponing two aviator classes and requesting a change in aircraft delivery dates.

b. Aviator training classes P-4 and P-5 are changed from 18 and 25 July to 22 Aug and 12 Sep respectfully. The reason for the change was lack of personnel to be trained. One instructor pilot is to be trained in Class OH-58-6-72, 4-17 Sep, and the second IP sometime in Oct 71.

c. Enlisted training: MAJ Harden requested that the 5th Avn Det provide the initial two weeks of training and the Australians would complete their own OJT. Subsequently class EM-2 and EM-3 will be conducted during the periods 25 Jul to 7 Aug and 8 to 21 Aug, respectfully. Class EM-4 will be conducted during Sep or Oct and is to be coordinated at a later date. Major Harden requested two additional quotas to the T-63 Engine Repair Course at AARTS. AFV personnel are scheduled to attend the T-63 course on 22 Aug.

d. Aircraft issue: MAJ Harden requested acceleration of the aircraft issuance to three aircraft on 23 July (no change), two aircraft on 6 Aug (in lieu of 22 Aug) and three aircraft on 3 Sep (in lieu of 19 Sep).

e. The changes were acceptable per guidance received from COL Torgersen during previous discussions on the support of this Memorandum of Agreement.

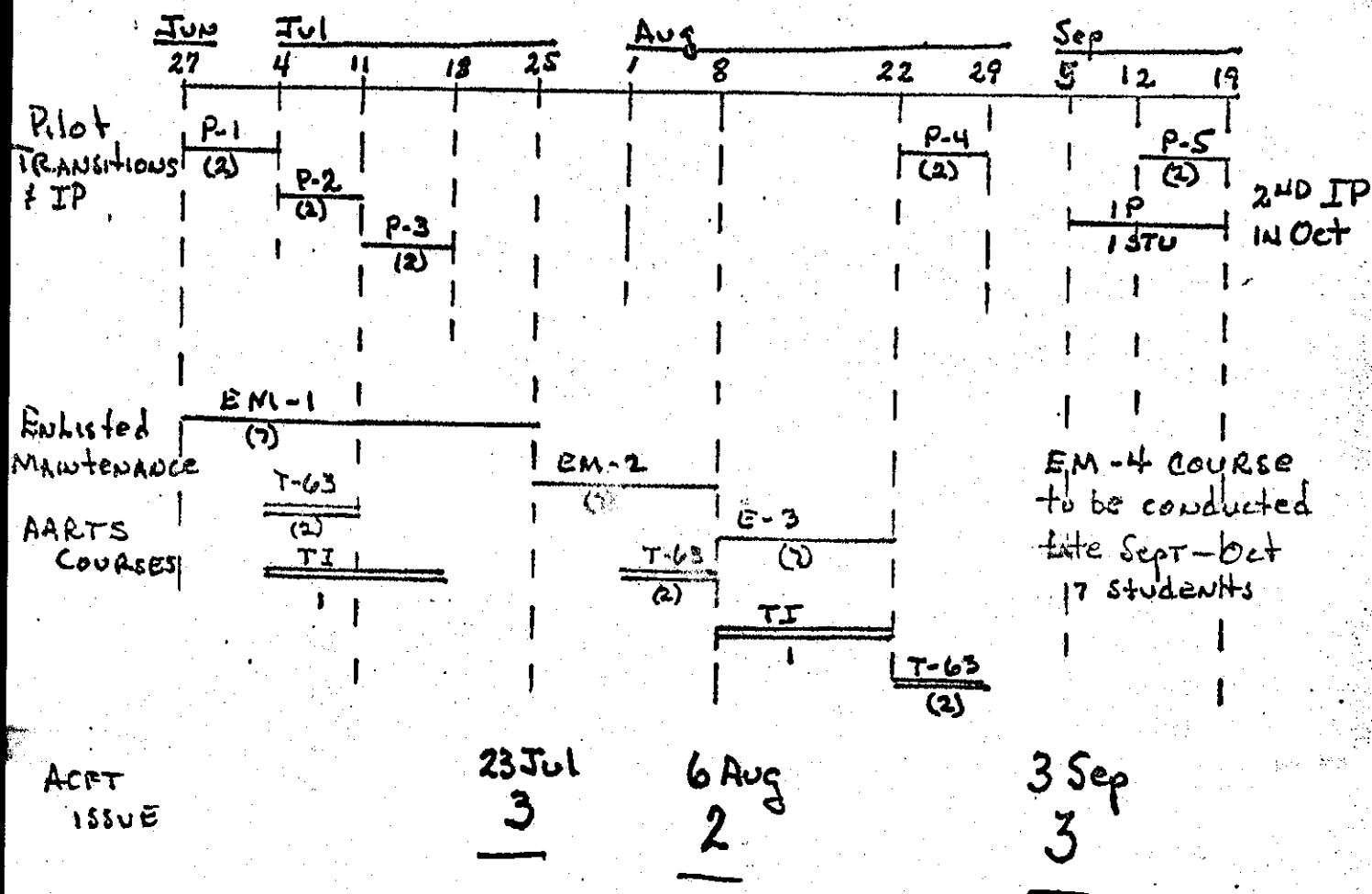
