SUBJECT: O-1 Transition Training for USAF FAC Advisors,  
After-action Report

1. Purpose. Information

2. Background. a. On 5 Dec 71, transition training for USAF FAC Advisors in the O-1G aircraft was approved by this headquarters. The training was to be conducted by the 74th RAC. Scheduled input was two pilots per week for five weeks, for a total of ten transitions. Direct coordination between 74th RAC and Maj Wilke, Air Force Advisory Group, was authorized.


b. On 15 Jan 72, training commenced. Two USAF FAC Advisors were transitioned prior to the 74th RAC receiving KEYSTONE instructions on 22 Jan 72. In order to continue the training commitment, two O-1G aircraft were transferred to the 388th Transportation Company at Vung Tau, RVN on 23 Jan 72. One IP and one crew-chief were assigned special duty with the 5th Aviation Detachment, Vung Tau, RVN. Complete coordination was made between LTC Burrows, Plans/Operations, 34th GSG, Maj McCormack, CO, 74th RAC, Maj Crissman, CO, 5th Avn Det, and Maj Wilke, AFAG.

c. Training was terminated on 1 Feb 72. A Total of six USAF FAC Advisors were transitioned. This was all requested by the USAF. Total flight time was fifty-two hours and fifteen minutes. Military interdepartmental purchase request (MIPR) is being processed between the 12th Combat Aviation Group and USAF for reimbursement funds.
