Dear Gary,

I have some info for you on Cpt Larry Dewey. (p. 153 and p. 212) He was KIA on 5/24/71 while with the 92nd AHC Stallions in a UH-1H. Sp4 Lubben was probably the crew chief or door gunner, but I'm not sure. The word we got back at Song Ba Thin was he was on an ammo resupply mission near Firebase 5 or 6, north of Pleiku. They were hit by an RPG

on short final while loaded with ammo. The aircraft exploded before it hit the ground. Since it was a hot area, I don't know if the bodies were recovered. There should have been 2 others KIA, but I don't remember any names. I hope this helps.
