

Dear Warrant Officer Konek:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request of 12 January 1992, concerning information on Marine Corps air operations in 1968 during the Vietnam War.

Enclosed is the Air Operations excerpt from Operations of U.S. Marine Forces, Vietnam: February 1968, which details Marine fixed wing and helicopter activities during the specific period cited in your letter. The complete February 1968 chapter of the volume cited above totals over 100 pages. Staff limitations, along with the many thousands of requests received in our office, unfortunately precludes us from undertaking extensive research and/or copying of historical materials.

It should be noted that the complete series of volumes on Operations of U.S. Marine Forces, Vietnam, 1965-1971 are unclassified and are held in the Library Section here at the Historical Center, where they are open for the use of interested researchers. We have enclosed a Guide to the Marine Corps Historical Center which details our research facilities and hours of operation, should you or any member of the Vietnam Helicopter Pilots Association wish to review these volumes or pursue further research in historical records.

We hope this information proves useful.
