We are sponsoring a care package drive for the service personnel in the Armed forces serving in Bosnia. Remember, men and women serve, and have different needs.

Here are a list of items we recommend.

Black knit hats. Black wool or knit gloves. Heavy dark socks. ZIPlockBags(1Gal.) size. Hard Candles. Cough drops. Crackers,munchies. Cheese spreads(non perishable) Wet ones or wet wipes. Toilet paper. Bar soap. Solid roll on deodorant. Tape videos (TV shows, news, movies) Audio Tapes(radio, music, say Hi, etc.) Newspapers, magazines. Writing paper and envelopes (nice way, to meet new friends)

Pepperoni. Canned Fruits. Peanut butter and jelly.

Condiments -individual packets(Mustard, mayonnaise, ketchup, hot sauce, soy sauce, duck, etc) Gum. Tea - regular, herb, decaf.

Note: US Customs states no CIGARETTES or Coffee.

The package may weigh up to 70lb and measure up to 108" in combined length and girth.

Sending a 30lb package 4th class will cost \$4.65 and it will take 3 weeks to get there. Get a receipt, this is a tax deduction.

We will collect items from you and mail them out. Just put items in the box provided. If you would like possible communication with your recipient, enclose a return addressed note.

Please state in your letter that you want your packages to go to service people in the field, these folks are having it the hardest.

Note: If you purchase items yourself, its tax deductible, make a note on your check " gift to service personnel in Bosnia.
