

## VHPA Combat Unit Database

A. The VHPA Combat Unit database is named COMBUNIT.DBF and is maintained utilizing the Microsoft FOX PRO software. This database should be compatible with dBASE III PLUS and dBASE IV software. This database is maintained by the VHPA Directory Committee and used by various VHPA Committees. The VHPA Administrative Services Contractor (current PAI in Cincinnati) maintains the VHPA Membership database but has not knowledge of the Combat Unit database.

B. BACKUP copies of the database should be made on standard 1.4MB 3 1/2 inch floppy discs. Copies are routinely distributed between the Directory and Data Base Committees. PKZIP is the software for producing these BACKUPS.

**RAWCODE** - generally the name of a military unit that served in Southeast Asia during the Vietnam Era. Examples: "C/159 AVN" "C/159 ASHC" "C/7/17 CAV" "USARV FLT DET" "3 BDE 4 INF" "HMM-362". Description: A 20 character, left justified field. This field holds the values used in the FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH, FIFTH, SIXTH, SEVENTH, and EIGHTH fields in the VHPA Membership Database. All alphabetic characters must be capital letters. Numeric characters are allowed. Certain special characters (e.g. "/", "(", ")", and "-") are allowed. Characters on the right side of the field that are not used are set to " " as in blank. The RAWCODE field is mandatory for all records in the database. The code of only one unit can appear in this field.

**SORTKEY** - is a private, disposable field that allows pilots in the Membership Database with different unit codes (e.g. "C/159 AVN" and "C/159 ASHC") to be associated with the same unit. Examples: "AA003" "AK07A" "AK07C". Description: A 5 character, alphanumeric field. The first character is a letter. All letters appear as capital letters. Blanks are not allowed. SORTKEY is a mandatory field for any RAWCODE value that needs to appear in the Directory index. This field is only used for preparing the Directory index.

**ENGLISH** - is a field that holds the label text for the combat units that appear in the Directory index. Examples: "192d Avn (AHC) Co" "? unit 2d Sqdn 1st Cav". Description: A 35 character, free form text field. The same text should appear for all record with the same SORTKEY.

ENGLISH is a mandatory field for any SORTKEY value that needs to appear in the Directory index. This field is only used for preparing the Directory index.

**PUBLISH** - is the preferred text name for a combat unit. This is the name that will appear in all database published VHPA documents (e.g. the Historical Reference Directory, the unit in the KIA/MIA section of the Membership Directory). It is also used by the desktop publishing software to develop the Unit Index in the Historical Reference Directory. Description: A 35 character, free form text field. PUBLISH is a mandatory field for any SORTKEY value that needs to be published in a standard form.

**UIC\_CODE** - is the unit identification code for this combat unit. Description: A 6 character, alphanumeric field of the form ABCDEF as described in AR 18-50 Briefly, position A = "W" to denote an Army unit. The B, C, and D positions can include any alphanumeric character except "O" (as in capital "O" as in Oscar and capital "I" as in India) These characters are not used since they can easily be confused with the numbers "0" (as in zero) and "1" (as in one). All letters are capital letters. The E and F positions have a meaning (e.g. "A0" generally means A Company, A Troop, or A Battery). **UIC\_CODE** is a highly desired field for any SORTKEY value or unique unit in the database. More will be said about UIC-CODEs in this document.

**BRANCH** - is a field inserted by Gary so he can define it. Examples: ? Description: A 2 character code field.

**MAJ\_CODE** - is a field inserted by Gary so he can define it. Examples: ? Description: A 2 character code field.

#### **D. COMBUNIT has the following uses.**

D.1. The database was initially built in August, 1993 when the Directory Editor was wrestling with ways to prepare the Combat Unit Index for the Membership Directory. The initial task was to convert all possible RAWCODE values to a common SORTKEY and then to print the text in ENGLISH in the index. This functions is still used for each issue of the Directory. Briefly, a FOXPRO program reads each record in the Membership Database and for VHPA members or potential members, uses the values in the FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH, FIFTH, SIXTH, SEVENTH, and EIGHTH fields as a key for the COMBUNIT database that is indexed by RAWCODE. A match results in the pilot's name and the SORTKEY being added as a new record to a temporary database. When all the Membership records have been worked, the temporary database is indexed by SORTKEY and name to produce an alphabetic list of pilots that served in the unit represented by the SORTKEY value. Then another FOXPRO program "unloaded" the temporary database into an input file for the desk top publishing software. Whenever a new SORTKEY value is detected, the ENGLISH text is retrieved from the COMBUNIT database and printed as a header for this list of names to follow.

D.2. When the VHPA decided to start collecting and using UIC codes, the COMBUNIT database was the logical repository because it was already organized by unit. Populating the **UIC\_CODE** fields is an on-going effort. The VHPA currently has three major sources for determining the **UIC\_CODE** for a particular unit. First, the catalog of Army units. VHPA member Skip Butler found this in a library. Appendix A contains a sample page from this report. Second, the GOLDBOOK database. Appendix B contains a sample listing of several records from this database. Third Vietnam Era orders. Appendix C contains a copy of an order that includes UIC data.

The programs that prepare the Historical Reference Directory use the UIC code in the HELICOPTER database as a key for the COMBUNIT database that is indexed by **UIC\_CODE**. A match results in the extract of the PUBLISH field for use in the production effort.

#### **MORE ON UICs**

The VHPA has yet to determine if other American armed services used UICs. Clearly we could use UICs for USMC and USAF helicopter units but to date we have not seen any. AR 18-50 addresses all Army units and was published 28 Jun 1967. The AR supersedes an earlier version dated 23 Nov 1965 and a DA message dated 29 Jun 1965. These conditions raise several challenges as follows:

D.2.1 What do we do with Army units that served in Vietnam prior to June 1965 and therefore do not have official UICs? The obvious examples are the CH-21 companies such as the 8th, 33rd, 57th, 80th, and 93rd Transportation Companies. ANSWER - The solution seems to be for the VHPA to generate a UIC for these units.

D.2.2 How do we know the UIC code for a given unit (e.g. WFJ4C0 for C/158 AVN 101 ABN) is correct because some times the sources present different codes? ANSWER - Skip Butler may have a source that will do two things for the VHPA: first, decode a specific UIC value into the unit's name and second, given a unit - provide the official UIC.

D.2.3 What happens when the VHPA has been using a given UIC for a given unit and learns that we need to change the UIC? ANSWER - write a program that scan all VHPA source databases and makes the change.

D.3. GARY - I think you are going to use the UIC\_CODE decode (as above) for presentation in the KIA/MIA section of the Directory. Correct?

E. How the fields and records work together. The following table presents selected fields from consecutive COMBUNIT records when the database was indexed by SORTKEY.

Since the RAWCODE field must match the FIRST, SECOND, etc. fields in the Membership Database, all valid codes used for the unit in the Membership Database must appear as a record in the COMBUNIT Database. Here we see two different codes of the Headquarters and Headquarters Company, three different codes for A Company, two for B Company, and only one for C Company. This is what works currently. However, there is no limit to the number of codes a given unit can have. The SORTKEY values are the same for each unit. Thus AC04K appears in the three A Company records. Naturally, there is only one UIC code for a unit so this code appears only once in the database and it really does not matter which of the unit's records hosts the code. The PUBLISH values are the same for each unit. Not shown in this table is the ENGLISH field. For each record the ENGLISH and the PUBLISH fields are identical except for the battalion level record - the last one in the table "158 AVN 101 ABN". Here is PUBLISH field = "158th Avn 101st Abn" and the ENGLISH field = "? unit 158th Avn 101st Abn".

E. Database updates. Currently the COMBUNIT Database is maintained by Mike Law. Anyone desiring to update the database can submit a list of add, change, delete items or provide an database that can be added via the APPEND command. Copies of the COMBUNIT Database are distributed on request to anyone in the VHPA.
