1. SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- a. On 6 November the COMUSMACV, General WESTMORELAND was briefed on the status of MAG-36 by the Group Commander.
- b. A detachment of 2 UH-1E's and 2 CH-46A's from MAG-36 were stationed in the Dak To area from 18 November to 28 November on a classified mission.
- c. The Civic Affairs Med Cap team made three visits to Ly Son (Cu Lao Re) Island during the month. Soap, tooth brushes and educational material were distributed. 185 medical and 37 dental patients were treated during the month.
