This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request #98-0335 dated 8 Dec 97.

We have researched all available files and have no record of witness statements concerning the individuals on your list.

We have, however, attached documents in our possession which best shed light on the loss of the members in question. Personal identifying data as they relate to other persons have been deleted from the attached documents. The release of such information, if disclosed to the public, would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The authority for this exemption is in the United States Code, Title 5, Section 552(b)(6), and Air Force Instruction 37-131, paragraph 10.6.

If you interpret this "partial denial" and/or "no records" response as an adverse action, you may decide to appeal this decision and write to the Secretary of the Air Force within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. Include in the appeal your reasons for reconsideration and attach a copy of this letter. Mail to:
