Equipment shipped dir by sources of sup will be marked with proj code as indicated above and supplementary address code will be furnished by overseas commander.

Personal clothing will be as prescribed in AR 700-8400-1 (enl pers) and required pur item TA 50-901, Zone 1 (for Off and WO), as modified by DA msg 729355 DTG 232104Z Aug 65 and DA msg 730203 DTG 272257Z Aug 65. Organizational clothing and equipment as prescribed in paragraph 21, AR 220-10 (POM) and paragraph 28 AR 735-35, Zone 1 of TA 50-901, as modified by DA msg 729993 DTG 271441Z Aug 65. Gas mask with corrective lenses will be issued prior to departure of personnel who require them.
