Dear Paul,

I'm sending you copies of some of the orders I've found among my life's debris. They contain confirmation of the classes (71-1 & 71-3) and graduation of both Gregory W. Hermann and Robert L. Horst who were killed in April of 1972 as well as some seventeen year old addresses.

As I'm sure you'll notice, there is quite a bit of duplication of information. However, each set of orders includes more information, be it an additional name, social security number, class or address, so I've sent them incase anyone wants to delve deeper and search out some of these guys. I've also written notes on some of the orders supplying additional information pertaining to those orders.

From what I understand, an individual can obtain the address of someone, through financial records, if you have that person's social security number. The only problem is that a private investigator charges about \$25.00 apiece for this information so maybe we can find a member that has access to the necessary computers and is willing to run the numbers for either a bulk rate or at cost.

I think I may have some more information at my mother's house possibly including some class rosters for Class 71-1 (Ft. Wolters) and Class 71-3 (Ft. Rucker). If I do find anything else, I'll send it along.

I hope this information will be of some assistance and if I can do anything to help, please let me know (I don't have a computer).
