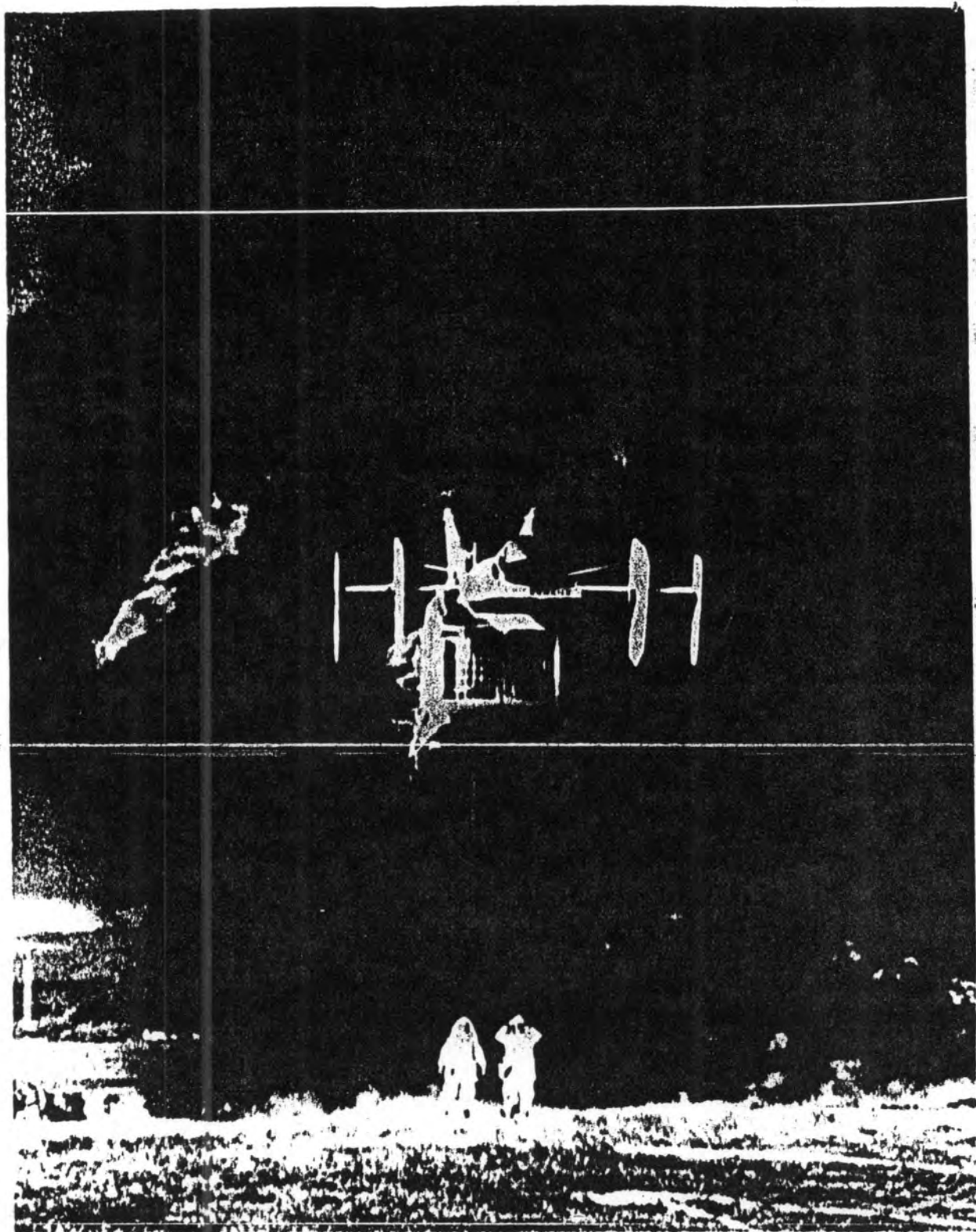

5. MAC PROP 72-33. MAC PROP 72-33, Inactivation of LBRs, is in the final steps of preparation in MAC and should be distributed in the early part of December. We again stress that we have attempted to anticipate possible problem areas and have provided pertinent guidance in the PROP, but local management efforts are the key to successful implementation of the PROP. 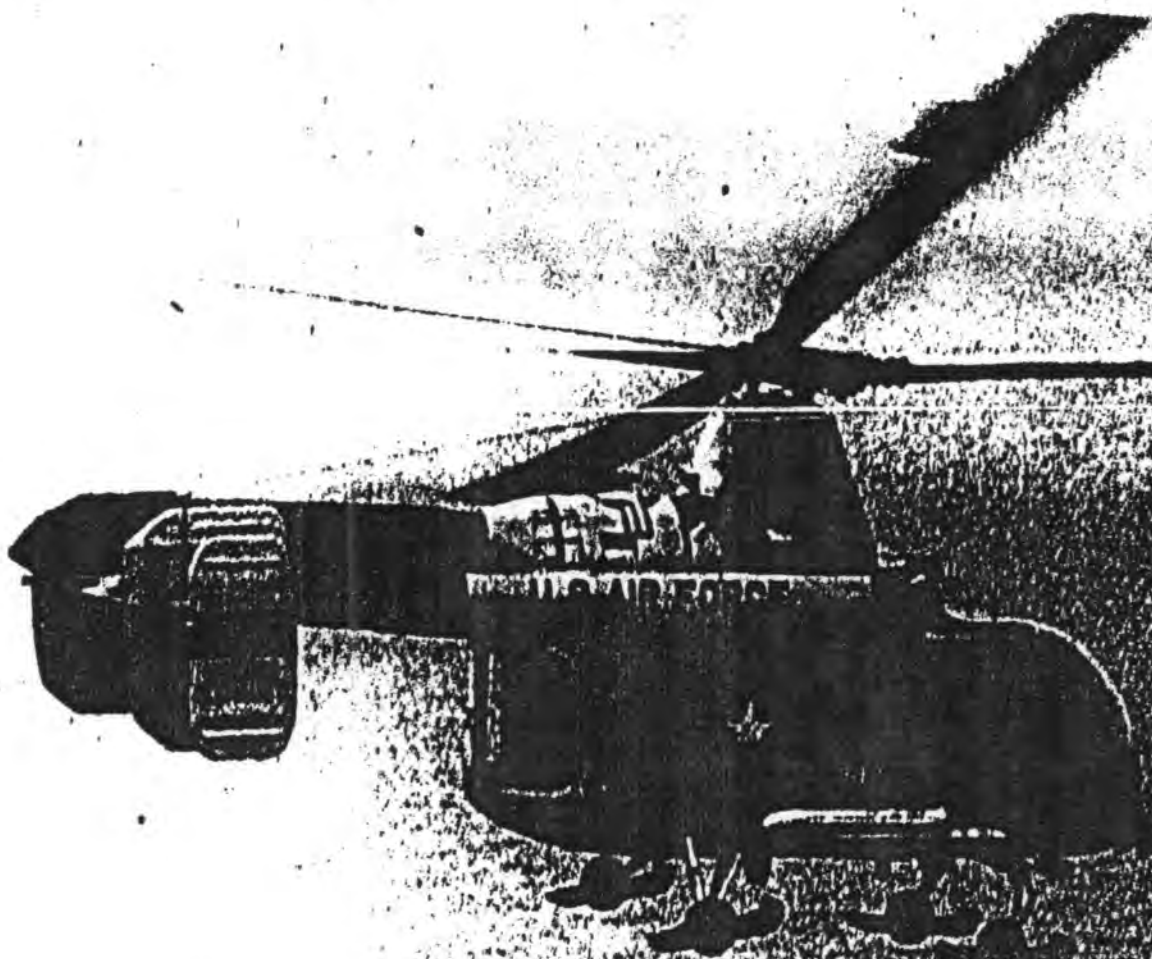
