I went into Fort Campbell, KY in the fall of 1966 and formed the 188<sup>th</sup> AHC, trained it and went to VN in April 1967. The company was assigned to the 269<sup>th</sup> CAB and stayed under their control until Jun/Jul when it moved to 101<sup>st</sup> area and became C Company, 101<sup>st</sup> Avn Bn. I left the compact and went to Bn Hqs in June 68 and was the Bn Safety Officer until August 68. I then was assigned to the 9th Avn Bn as the Safety Officer and remained with them until I rotated back in April 68.
