CIRCUMSTANCES OF LOSS: Chief Hall was the flight mechanic on an HH-3 helicopter which was on a rescue mission when he was reported missing in action. A downed member was hoisted aboard the helicopter and it was departing the area when it was struck by ground fire causing it to crash and explode. The helicopter pararescueman was thrown free, survived the crash and was rescued. Chief Hall was continued in a missing status until 29 May 1974 when his status was administratively changed by the Department of the Air Force to killed in action. Since his remains have not been recovered and returned, he is listed by the Department of Defense as unaccounted for in Southeast Asia.
