2. The above authority is granted only on condition that the applicant is a member of a Federally recognized unit.

3. The applicable fiscal year funds under Program 3100 will be cited for pay, allowances and travel.

4. Travel orders should be issued in accordance with the instructions contained in Joint Travel Regulation, 1 July 1965, and changes that may be made thereto.

5. Inability of this individual to attend school will be reported to the Chief, National Guard Bureau.

6. Family should not accompany the student. Accommodations for families are not available at the school.
