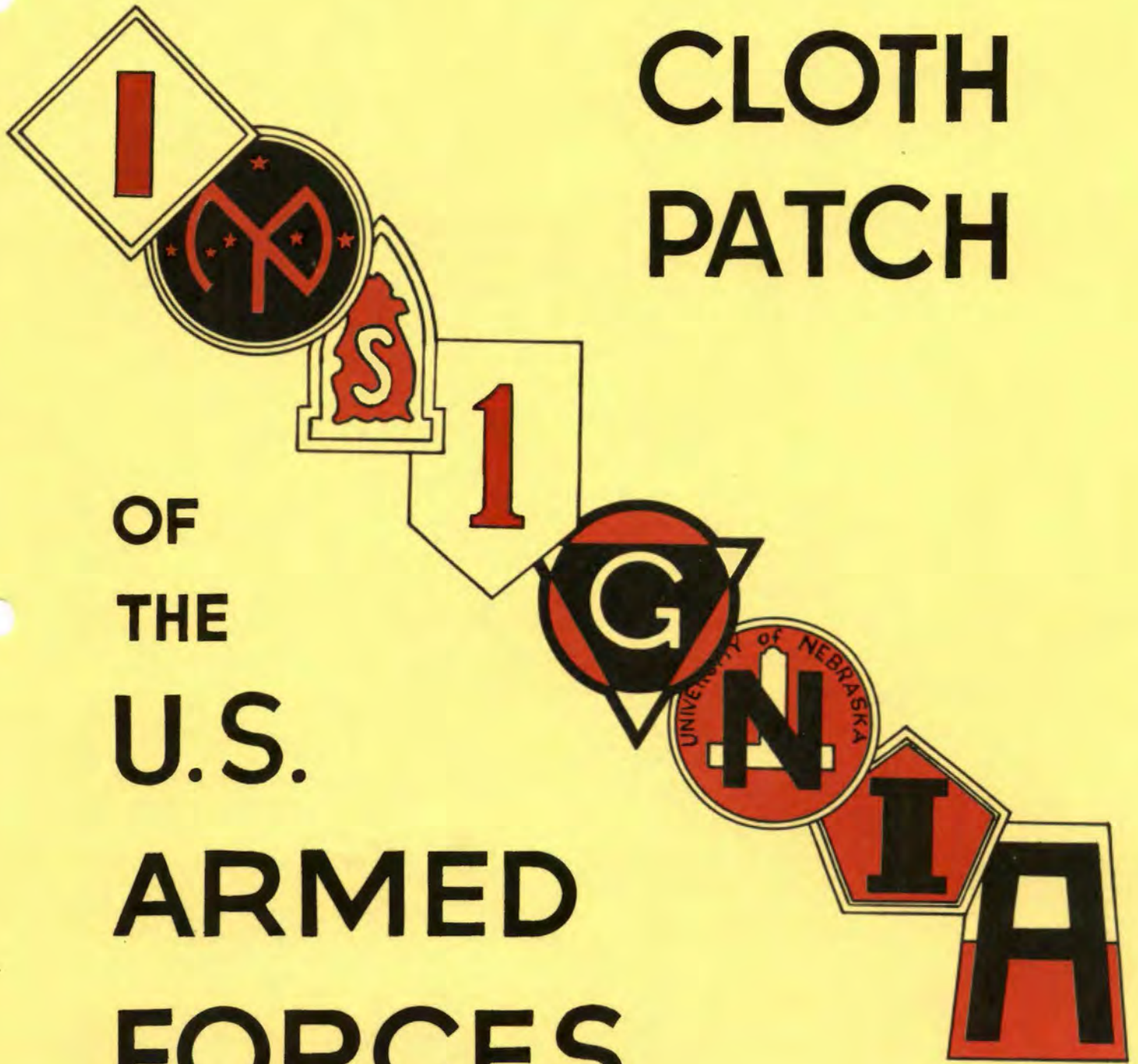

Div. now in other units might have the design facing forward when worn on the right sleeve. Same colors as 1C1 except bend and horse's head are facing in opposite directions. 1D 1st Cavalry Div. Commander Staff (b) Black bend and horse's head on a yellow shield. Two yellow stars on bend. 1E 1st Cavalry Div., 1st Brig. Commander (b) Black bend, red horse's head on a yellow shield. One yellow star on bend.
1A1 1st Armored Division (c) Basic design (see A1) with black Arabic numeral "1" in apex. Worn with tab "Old Ironsides" below insignia (black letters on a yellow background). Originally activated as the 7th Mechanized Cavalry Brigade on 1 March 1932. Redesignated 1st Armored Div. on 15 July 1940. WWII campaigns: North Africa, Italy. Now inactive.	1F 1st Cavalry Div., 1st Brig., 1st Regiment (b) Blue bend, red horse's head on a yellow shield.
1A2 1st Armored Division (c) Same as 1A1 without the tab.	1G 1st Cavalry Div., 1st Brig., 2nd Regiment (b) Two blue bends, red horse's head on a yellow shield.

(e) On a shield quartered yellow and red and bordered yellow, two crossed sabers partially enveloped by a garland in base, both yellow. On a double-arched black chief a yellow spur. Tab is black with yellow letters and border.
	1HH 1st Armored Div., Aviation(d) On a 5" green disc edged olive drab, the armored triangle-yellow, red, and blue-with black "1" in apex. Gray tank and wings, black gun barrel. "Old Ironwings" in blue on a yellow ribbon.		2A 2nd Armored Div. (o,d) Basic triangle design with Arabic numeral "2" in apex. Worn with tab "Hell on Wheels", yellow letters on khaki background. Activated on 15 July 1940. WWII campaigns: North Africa, Sicily, Northern France, Central Europe. Now on active duty.
	1JJ 1st Armored Div., Tanker(d) Not a shoulder insignia but an embroidered badge awarded by the Commanding General of the 1st Armored Div. to tank crews that have met specifications of proficiency. Green losenge with yellow letters and border.		2B 2nd Cavalry Div. (b,o) On a yellow shield bordered olive drab, two eight-pointed stars above a chevron, all dark blue.

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	2C1 2nd Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "2" in apex.		3C 3rd Armored Cav. Regt.(c,d) On a green disc edged yellow, a yellow bugle. Gray cord, letters, number.
	2C2 2nd Armored Div. (c) Same as 2C1, except small "2".		3D 3rd Tank Battalion (c) On a green shield a silver dragon's head spewing red flames (edged black) and holding in its mouth a silver sword bendwise. Motto is red on a silver scroll.
	2D1 2nd Armored Cav. Regt. (c,d) On a black disc a white fleur-de-lis on a green flower with a gold octagonal background. Motto is gold on a green tab.		3E 3rd Armored Recon. Bn.(d) Basic triangle design with black "3" in apex and the black letters "RCN" in base.
	2D2 2nd Armored Cav. Regt. (d) On a yellow eight-pointed star of rays, a green palmetto leaf charged with a white fleur-de-lis. Yellow motto on a green ribbon scroll. All on a black disc.		4A 4th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black Arabic "4" in apex.
	3A1 3rd Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black Arabic numeral "3" in apex. Activated 15 April 1941. WWII campaigns: Northern France, Central Europe. Now on active duty.		4B1 4th Cavalry Regt. (c,d) On a yellow shield edged red, an embattled medium blue pale over a red saber bendwise, the pale charged with a yellow cannon muzzle down. On the cannon a saber, bayonet, and arrow all crossed and red.
	3A2 3rd Armored Div. (d) Same as 3A1 with the addition of a tab "Spearhead". Black letters on a yellow background bordered olive drab.		4B2 4th Cavalry Regt.(c,d,e) Similar to 4B1 except pale is light blue and border is yellow.
	3B 3rd Cavalry Division (b,c) A blue number "3" on a yellow shield.		4B3 4th Cavalry Regt. (c,d) Similar to 4B2 except for shape of shield.

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	4C 4th Cavalry Regt., 2nd Squadron (d) On a dark green shield the insignia of the 4th Cav. Regt. (light blue pale, yellow shield and cannon, red swords, arrow, and bayonet). Crest is a green cratered mount bearing a yellow saber bendwise and in the crater a red kris. Wreath is light blue and yellow.		6A 6th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "6" in apex. Activated 15 February 1942. WWII: Northern France, Central Europe. Now inactive.
	4D 4th Reconnaissance Sq. (d) On a yellow shield a red lightning bolt bendwise crossed by a black spearhead palewise. The motto is yellow on a black scroll. The designation is white on a black tab.		6B1 6th Armored Cav. Regt. (c,d) On a blue shield with black outer and thin orange-gold inner border, an orange-gold unicorn.
	4E 4th Medical Troop (Mechanized) (b) On a dark maroon disc bordered white, a black tank track with yellow lightning flash superimposed. White caduceus in base.		6B2 6th Armored Cav. Regt. (c,d) On a dark blue shield with yellow inner border, a rampant yellow unicorn. Design differs from 6B1.
	5A 5th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "5" in apex. Activated 1 Oct. 1941. WWII campaigns: Northern France, Central Europe. Now inactive.		6C 6th Cavalry Regt. (b) A blue "6" on a yellow shield.
	5B 5th Cavalry Regt. (d) Similar to 5A except for black letters "CAV" in base.		7A 7th Cavalry Regt. (d) On a gold horseshoe (black nail-holes) a white gauntlet holding upright a white sword both picked out in yellow. In base a light blue and yellow wreath. Motto is yellow on a light blue scroll.
	5C 5th Cavalry Regt., Honor Guard (d) On a gold shield with black border, the distinctive insignia of the 5th Cavalry Regt. in gold, black, and red. Letters and numbers are black.		7B 7th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "7" in apex. Activated 1 March 1942. WWII: Central Europe.
	5D 5th Quartermaster Regt. (Mechanized) (b) On a light buff disc bordered black, a black tank track with superimposed yellow lightning flash. Yellow quartermaster insignia in base.		7C1 7th Cavalry Regt. (c) Black bend, black horse's head on a yellow shield bordered black. Black Arabic numeral "7" in base.

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	7C2 7th Cavalry Regt. (e) Black bend, black horse's head on a field green shield bordered black. Black numeral "7" in base.		8A 8th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black numeral "8" in apex. Activated 1 April 1942, WWII: campaigned in Europe.
	7D1 7th Cavalry Regt. (e) Black bend, black horse's head on a yellow shield bordered black. Black "7" in base. "CAVALRY" is yellow. Tab has "VIET NAM" in black letters on a yellow background.		8B1 8th Cavalry Regt. (d,e) On a green background a white horse above a yellow bar. Motto is in yellow letters on a black scroll bordered yellow.

	7E1 7th Cavalry Brigade (Mech-anized) (b) This unit was the beginning of the modern Armored Forces as we know it today. The insignia consisted of a yellow disc, a red lightning flash superimposed on a black tank track. Black Arabic numeral "7" in base.		8C 8th Cavalry Regt. (d) On a shield divided by a white bend into red (top) and dark blue, a white skull picked out in black. "Mountaineers" is in black letters; "8th Cav. Regt." in white.
	7E2 7th Cavalry Brigade (Mech-anized) (b) Identical with 7E1 except number has been removed. Numbers were originally worn on many of the patches but were subsequently removed.		8D 8th Reconnaissance Co.(d) On a gold triangle a pouncing black puma. Letters are black.
	7F 7th Army Tank Training Center (c) Basic design with letters in black.		8E 8th Armored Group (d) Basic design with black "8GP" in apex.
	7G 7th Cavalry Regt. (d) Basic design with black "7" in apex and black "CAV" in base.		9A 9th Armored Div. (o) Basic design with black "9" in apex. Activated 15 July 1942. WWII: Europe.

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	10A 10th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "10" in apex. Activated July 1942 WWII: Europe.		11C1 11th Armored Cav. Regt.(e) On a field green shield bordered black, a black rearing horse superimposed on a black sinister bend. (Made in Viet Nam.)
	10B 10th Armored Div. (c) On a disc divided medium blue (top) and yellow, a snarling tiger's head in orange, black, and white. Mouth is red. (Designed in 1942 by Walt Lantz Studios).		11C2 11th Armored Cav. Regt.(e) A shield divided per black sinister bend red (above) and white with a black rearing horse superimposed on the bend. White portion extends around red portion. (See "Late Additions" for more variations.)
	10C 10th Cavalry Regt. (d) On a white disc edged black a brown buffalo edged gold on a gold and black wreath. Motto is gold on a black ribbon.		12A 12th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "12" in apex. Activated 15 Sept. 1942. WWII: Europe.
	10D 10th Cavalry Regt. (d) The 8th Army insignia (an octagon divided into 8 sections, white on red) with two tabs: upper, "10th Cavalry"; lower, "7th Division". All numbers and letters are red on yellow backgrounds with thin red-stitch borders.		13A 13th Armored Division (c) Basic design with black "13" in apex. Activated 15 Oct. 1942. WWII: Europe.
	10E 10th Cavalry Regt. (d) The 7th Division insignia (black hourglass on red disc with black border) with "10th Cav." in yellow letters. Tab is red with black "Korea" and border.		13B 13th Cavalry Regt. (Mech-anized) (b) On a yellow disc a red lightning flash superimposed on a black tank track.

	15B 15th Cavalry Regt. (c,d) On a gold-bordered shield divided per fess red and white, in chief a gold lion and in base a kriss and kam-pilan in saltire, both black.		17C 17th Armored Group (d) Basic design with black "17 GP" in apex.
	16A 16th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "16" in apex. Activated July 1943. WWII: Europe.		18A 18th Armored Div. (c) Basic design with black "18" in apex. Patch was made up but unit never activated.
	16B 16th Armored Div., 3rd Bn.(c) Basic design with black "3/16" in apex.		18B 18th Infantry Tank Co. (c) Basic design with the distinctive insignia of the 18th Infantry Regt. superimposed on the tank track. The distinctive has a blue shield with white saltire and charges. On a white chief a red bend between two blue fleur-de-lis. Motto is black on a blue scroll. Samples were made up but insignia was never used.
	16C 16th Armored Group (d) Basic design with black "16GP" in apex.		19A 19th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "19" in apex. Patch was made up but unit never activated. Following WWII activated in the Organized Reserve.
	17A 17th Armored Div. (e) Basic design with black "17" in apex. Patch was made up but unit never activated.		19B 19th Ordnance Troop (Mech-anized) (b) On a red disc bordered yellow a yellow lightning flash superimposed on a black tank track. Yellow Ordnance Symbol in base.

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	20A 20th Armored Div. (o) Basic design with black "20" in apex. Activated 13 March 1943. WWII: Europe.		24A2 24th Cavalry Div. (b) Same as 24A1 but on a yellow disc.
	21A 21st Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "21" in apex. Following WWII activated in the Organized Reserve.		24A3 24th Cavalry Div. (b) Same as 24A1 with the addition of a yellow border.
	21B1 21st Cavalry Div. (o) On a yellow felt disc, a purple flower with green leaves within a black stirrup.		27A 27th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "27" in apex. Worn with tab "EMPIRE" beneath patch. Yellow letters on a blue background.
	21B2 21st Cavalry Div. (o) On a yellow stirrup-shaped background a purple flower with green leaves, all within a black stirrup border.		30A 30th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "30" in apex. Letters of tab are dark blue on a yellow background with a miniature insignia of the 30th Inf. Div. on either side. Formed upon conversion of the 44th Inf. Div. After Korea this unit was to be renamed the 44th Arm. Div. and assigned to Tenn. Tenn., however, wishing to perpetuate the number and honors of the 30th Inf., received permission to have the number changed to 30th Arm. Div.
	22A 22nd Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "22" in apex. Activated as a reserve division in 1953. Subsequently redesignated as the 75th Infantry Division.		30B 30th Tank Battalion (d) On a green shield a yellow bend regularly charged with three pairs of green spear points in saltire. Motto is in yellow letters on a green scroll outlined yellow.
	23A 23rd Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "23" in apex. Insignia exists but no information is available on this unit.		31A 31st Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "31" in apex.
	24A1 24th Cavalry Div. (b) On a yellow background a red rose with green leaves, all within a black stirrup border.		32A 32nd Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "32" in apex.

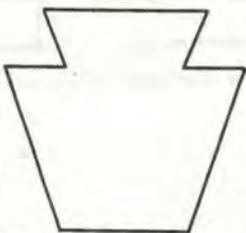

	33B 33rd Armored Cav. Regt. (d) On a green shield a border of 33 silver discs. Motto is green on a white scroll. Area between scroll and shield is black.		37A 37th Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "37" in apex.
	34A 34th Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "34" in apex.		39A 39th Infantry Regt. Tank Company (o) Basic design with black letters "Tank Co." in apex and "39th Inf." in base.
	34B 34th Armored Cav. Regt. (d) On a dark blue shield edged yellow a brownish flesh-colored arm holding a yellow buckler with blue rivets.		40A 40th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "40" in apex. Tab has yellow letters between two yellow suns (insignia of the 40th Infantry Division) on a dark blue background.
	35A 35th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "35" in apex.		40B 40th Armor, 5th Medium Tank Bn. (d) Basic design with black "5/40" in apex.

	41B 41st Scout Dog Platoon(d) Black bend, black horse's head on a yellow shield edged olive drab. Designation is black on a yellow scroll bordered olive drab.		47A 47th Engineer Troop (Mech-anized) (b) Red disc bordered white with a white lightning flash superimposed on a black tank track.
	42A 42nd Armored Bn. (c) Basic design with black "42" in apex.		48A 48th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "48" in apex. Tab is yellow with black letters. Formed in 1955 on conversion of the 48th Infantry Division.
	43A 43rd Armored Bn. (c) Basic design with black "43" in apex.		49A 49th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "49" in apex. Tab is yellow with black star and letters. This unit is a Texas Nat. Guard Division formed in 1948 upon the reorganization of the National Guard.
	44A 44th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "44" in apex. This unit was redesignated the 30th Armored Division before activation, but the patch was made before activation was announced.		50A 50th Armored Div. (d) Basic design with black "50" in apex. Tab is yellow with dark blue letters. New Jersey is the home of this division which was activated in 1953.
	45A 45th Armored Bn. (c) Basic design with black "45" in apex.		51A 51st Armored Infantry Battalion (c) Basic design with black "51" in apex.
	45B 45th Armored Recon. Bn.(d) On a bronze-colored shield a green palm tree (white trunk) and a green dragon (red wings, breast, tongue, and claws). On a bronze tab "Panama" in green. Motto is green on a bronze scroll.		52A 52nd Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "52" in apex.

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	52B 52nd Cavalry Brigade (b) A plain yellow keystone.		56B 56th Cavalry Brig. (b) On a khaki disc a red Zia or Pueblo Indian sun symbol on a yellow star.
	52C 52nd Cavalry Brig. (b) Black "A" upon a red keystone. While part of the 1st Army, the 52nd was attached to the 28th Div. for administrative purposes. This design of the black "A" of the 1st Army on the red keystone of the 28th Div. shows its dual role. In the mid-1930's it was changed to the yellow keystone of 52B because it too closely resembled that of the 28th Division.		57A 57th Armored Bn. (d) Basic design with black "57" in apex.
