3. (C) EXECUTION:

a. Concept of Operations:

(1) Maneuver: Commencing 090530 Nov 66 Troop D supported by Engr Plt conducts "Road Runner" operations on Rte 506 from Psn POINT to RJ Rte 506 & 1 in conjunction with air and ground recon of Rte 506 Valley by Troop C and attached Recon Plt. Troop D will clear a platoon sector on each side of Rte 506. Troop C will air assault ground recon platoons to high ground on either side of the valley and clear suspected infiltration routes down slope towards Rte 506.

(2) Fires: 105mm fires available from LZ's HEAD & STUART. 175mm & 8" fires from Psn CRYSTAL; Channel 27A (34.50). ARA strip alert Psn HAMOND.

b. Troop C:

(1) Air assault ground recon platoons into LZ's on high ground either side of 506 Valley and clear suspect routes vic BR873787 to BR860780 and vic BR825758 to BR849767 to BR840783.

(2) Conduct air recon of 506 area.

(3) Air support Troop D as required.

(4) Assume OCA Recon Plt ____ Cav.

c. Troop D:

(1) Depart Psn HAMOND 090530 Nov and move via Rte 1, CP 21 and Psn BYRD so as to commence Road Runner ops on Rte 506 090800 hrs.

(2) Clear a platoon sector to include villages on either side of road.

(3) Maintain a one platoon reserve force on Rte 506.

(4) Assume OCA 1st Plt Co C 8th Engrs.

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d. Recon Plt ___ Cav: Oca to Troop C.

e. 1st Plt Co C 8th Engr:

(1) OCA to Troop D.

(2) Effect necessary repairs to Rte 506 to facilitate movement of Troop D vehicles.

(3) Be prepared to clear mines and obstacles as required.

f. Coordinating Instructions: Troop C will control all air strikes in the Rte 506 AO.
