Summary: LS, UH-1D medical helicopter standing ready at field hospital at Khe Sanh, pan to American pilots sitting atop sandbags. CUs, pilots discussing and looking at positions on map. CUs, faces of pilots as they sit and wait. MS, American soldiers unload wounded ARVNs from UH-1D. They carry the wounded on litters into field hospital. CUs, soldiers (45th Engr Gp, 18th Bde) wiring bangalore torpedo. They are preparing to destroy heavy barbed wire emplacement. CU, soldier throwing red smoke grenade to mark detonation area. LS, red smoke rising, bangalore torpedo explodes in fg. VS, engineers operate road graders and bulldozers to level and clear field. CU, pit filled with grenades, B-40 rockets, Claymore mines, dud chicom mortars and mini gun. Ammo was uncovered while clearing the area. CU, scattered wreckage of UH-1D which hit mine. LS, UH-1D and CH-47s landing on newly cleared strip. Engineers clear and level ground in fg. CUs, soldiers cautiously checking uncleared field, searching for mines, booby

traps and dud rounds. MS, palletted ammo stacked in field. CU, ARVN soldier checking ammo supply list. LS, 1st ARVN Hqs in Khe Sanh. CU, American air controller talking over radio directing helicopter traffic around 1st ARVN Hqs. Vietnamese soldiers rigging slingloads of supplies. LS, CH- 54A Skycranes pick up slingloads of ammo and carry them off. LS, CH-47 Chinook coming in and hooking up to slingload of supplies.
