The Second Directory

Last year, "Army Aviation Magazine," published its first directory of key aviation commanders and staff officers. This is a slight contradiction in itself and tends to be misleading, for aviation is so integrated within the Army that a separate breakout of all "key" commanders and staff officers would really have to be a directory of the entire Army structure. This is a healthy sign of maturity.

However, the usefulness of this particular compilation of aviation personnel lies in the editor's tireless efforts to pin down at one point in time the ever-changing people in the program who deal in the day-to-day basic problems of Army aviation. The list does not pretend to be exhaustive, nor to have incorporated last week's changes, but I have found the '67 Directory to be extremely useful and a unique source of information.

The five-fold increase in personnel listings in this year's Directory, and the ad-

dition of pertinent telephone listings, make the '68 Directory a veritable "Who's Who."

I would suggest that all readers inform the editor of any "unit" omissions or additions they note so that the '69 Directory may be even more complete. I wish it were possible to publish such a Directory more frequently than annually, but I recognize that time and cost factors prohibit this. Through separate monthly "Command & Staff" listings in "Army Aviation," and the up-dating procedures spelled out on the previous page, the editor believes that you can keep your personal copy current on a full-year basis.

It is my earnest hope that our increase in aviator strength and our growing training bases will lend a degree of stability to our program and will lessen personnel turbulence in the future.

As the Director of Army Aviation I am keenly aware that the most valuable asset in our program is the people who make it function. You have established a proud record in the last year and have created an image of true responsiveness — the very hallmark of organic aviation.

This plaque goes to each Army pilot who logs a thousand flying hours in the Army Mohawk surveillance system. This month Grumman salutes Major David Clark and Captain Paul E. Bishop, both of whom have earned the plaque.



Man is the heart of the system. Grumman never forgets it.

Major David Clark has served two tours in Vietnam for a total of 29 months. From September 1964 to September 1965, Major Clark served with the 23rd Special Warfare Aviation Detachment and the 73rd Aviation Company. From April 1966 to September 1967, Major Clark served as operations officer with the 73rd AVN Co. and S-2 with the 222nd Aviation Battalion. Major Clark has over 3500 total flying hours with 1300 Mohawk hours — 960 of which he accrued in combat in Vietnam. While in RVN, Major Clark was awarded a DFC with oak leaf cluster, Soldier's Medal, Bronze Star with "V" device and 3 oak leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal, and the Air Medal with "V" device and 27 oak leaf clusters. Major Clark is presently assigned to the Limited War Labs. at Aberdeen, Maryland.

Captain Paul E. Bishop is presently on duty with the 225th Aviation Company in Vietnam. This is his second tour in RVN, having served with the 73rd Aviation Company for a year in 1965. Prior to that assignment, Capt. Bishop served 17 months flying Mohawks with the 101st Airborne Division ASTA Platoon. Capt. Bishop has been awarded the Bronze Star, Army Commendation Medal, and the Air Medal with "V" device and 18 clusters.

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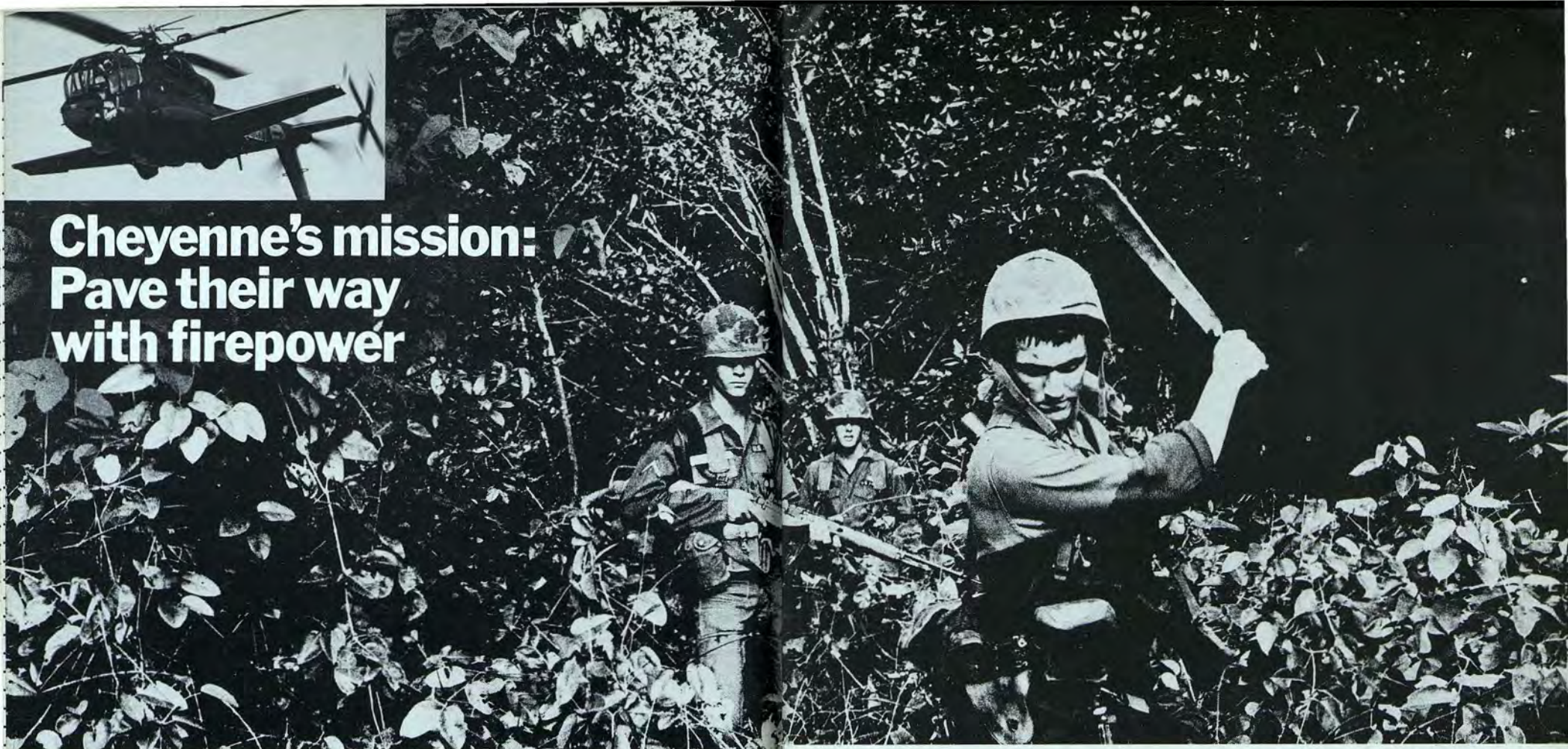

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THE Director of Army Aviation has asked me, his Deputy, to write this month's letter since I have recently returned from a short trip to Vietnam. I hasten to assure you that I am not going to file a report based on "instant expertise" or treat the reader as a captured audience for any of my war stories.

Also, I hasten to denounce all those who have implied that the timing of my trip had a direct bearing on the *TET offensive*. (Unfortunately, there is nothing in dispatches to show my presence turned the tide of any particular engagement).

Personal impressions

What I would like to report can be classed as impressions of the great flexibility of Army aviation and the important intangibles that are its greatest attributes — such as responsiveness, dedication, and a "can do" attitude that is so hard to put in print and so difficult to feed into the cost-effectiveness computer.

From the professional point of view the highlight of my visit to Vietnam occurred during the period 29 January-1 February. This was the beginning of the so-called *TET offensive*. It was during these days and the succeeding days after I had left Vietnam that Army aviation — its pilots, mechanics, gunners — so endeared themselves to many of our commanders and staff officers in the Saigon-Long Binh area where previously little action had been observed, certainly at such close hand.

I was privileged to be staying with *General*

Bob Williams and when the alerts sounded we bounced out of bed, grabbed a *Huey*, and immediately checked into the 12th Combat Aviation Group control net. There were ground attacks in several areas of the Long Binh-Bien Hoa perimeter and a number of gunships were already airborne and were being directed to targets.

It was indeed interesting to watch a light fire team in action at night with one member using a searchlight to pick up the enemy and after finding them calling on his buddy to come in and "zap 'em". One interesting communication was heard on the radio wherein one member of a fire team said, "*Hey, Joe, there goes about 15 of them into that house. Come get 'em before they change their clothes and go to work!*"

Cool and calm

I was impressed with the professionalism of all hands that I observed and heard during this period of the *TET offensive*. The calmness and the voices of the men on the radios made you think they were merely calling for landing instructions at a peaceful U.S. airfield, and yet they were continuously in action for hours on end.

When the sun finally came up on the morning of 31 January, I was surprised to find that the VC were continuing to stay and fight. This gave us our gunships adequate opportunity to refuel and rearm and get back into the fray. A most interesting event took place early that morning when troops of the 101st Airborne Division were landed on the roof of the American Embassy in Saigon in

what I believe to be the first air assault operation ever conducted to the roof of a building.

Meanwhile, in the area around Tan Son Nhut and other outskirts of Saigon, gunships were literally hovering down the streets seeking out and destroying the enemy. Later that morning, we made the complete circuit of the III CTZ and whistled up all of our Army airfield commands to find out how things were going. In every case we found that everyone had been busy since midnight the night before, both on the ground repelling attacks against their perimeter, and mounting out their gunships, firefly missions, command and control ships, and in many cases conducting air assault operations.

The crippled Cobra

About mid-morning we landed at Bien Hoa and visited the 334th Gun Company and the *Cobra* NET Team. These guys had had everybody in action since early that morning and perhaps the most spectacular sight was a crippled *Cobra* approaching from the Saigon area and making a running landing between the revetments at the Bien Hoa heliport.

He had lost his tail rotor drive shaft, had two rounds in the fuel cells, and had a full panel of warning lights, yet he brought it home and stepped out and said, "Put this one aside and give me another one. There are more targets down there."

By the way, while mentioning Bien Hoa here is a quote from the 4 February *Air Force Daily Bulletin* at that station:

"Bien Hoa — Following a recent attack on Bien Hoa AB by the Viet Cong, the air base was able to make a rapid and complete recovery within a short time.

"Inter-service cooperation between the Air Force, Army, and Vietnamese forces con-

tributed greatly to the successful defense of the base and the speedy re-opening of the runway.

"U.S. Army units — The 145th Aviation Battalion and elements of the 101st Airborne Division — were standing by to lend support with their armed helicopters and combat troops.

"AH-1G HueyCobra helicopters from the 145th Aviation Battalion, firing rockets and mini-guns, combined with the security police to kill the infiltrators in a battle that lasted several hours.

"To date, at least 153 enemy troops are known to have been killed at Bien Hoa and 25 suspects detained. The number of VC killed outside the perimeter has not been counted."

Everybody is crazy about the *Cobra* and from all I could tell it is doing a tremendous job. It is a great improvement over the B and C models and should afford much of the expected additional firepower.

The LOH in action

One of the real sexy outfits in Vietnam today is the Air Cav Squadron. As many of you know we have had a squadron of this type in the airmobile division but only recently have we deployed squadrons in support of straight legged infantry divisions.

I spent the afternoon with LTC Kit Sinclair and his 3rd/17th Cav on one operation in the area near Tay Ninh. It was a most interesting day. Enemy mortar positions were located by the OH-6A scout helicopters and were attacked by gunships from LTC Sinclair's outfit, artillery from a nearby fire support base, and later by Air Force fighter bombers.

I was most impressed with the performance of the LOH and the guys that are flying them deserve a great deal of credit. They are truly performing in the scout role, flying with their skids in the tree tops at low air speeds seeking out the enemy positions in the jungle below. Although the LOH has been in-country only a short time it is already building a great reputation. While it looks fragile on the ground it apparently is a very sturdy aircraft in the air.

One striking example is the story (true, I

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am told) of the scout driver who hovered down a trail. He was *under* the jungle canopy some fifty yards away from his entry clearing when a number of VC jumped up and started taking pot shots at him. He had no alternative but to pull pitch and hack his way *out* to the top of the jungle. One limb came through the canopy between the pilot and observer, broke off, and came on home with the aircraft. There were various other nicks and scratches in the airframe and the rotor blades were wrinkled, *but he brought it home.*

The OH-6 is quite crashworthy, also. There have been several aircraft totaled in Vietnam with no injuries to the crew. It appears that the so-called "A" frame construction is a real bonus in this respect.

A day at Danang

I spent a day at Danang and visited the newly-activated 16th Aviation group commanded by *Colonel Dan Gust*. I was very impressed with the job the *Mohawk* and *Bird Dog* drivers are doing in the northern part of Vietnam. We also spent a short period of time with *General Tolson* at Headquarters of the 1st Cav. As advertised, they were busy being constantly on the move and constantly seeking out and destroying the enemy. I gather that the Marines were somewhat aghast when the 1st Cav moved into their

area complete with over 400 helicopters and their fast moving, hard-hitting tactics.

A most interesting afternoon was spent in the Delta where I ran into *Major Carl McNair* and his 121st Aviation Company at the little town of Vi Thanh. He was busily engaged with the ARVN 21st Infantry Division and I arrived there in time to take one of the liftships on an extraction operation.

It was a real pleasure to climb into a *Huey* with *WO Hardin*, a recent Wolters/Rucker graduate. I assured him this was not another school checkride, and then proceeded to observe the professionalism that he and the other aviators in the formation displayed.

Everything was timed down to the second with thirteen liftships and two light fire teams, picking up an entire company of ARVN Infantry in less than thirty seconds. One of the fire teams was a *Cobra* fire team proceeding to the PZ. The fire teams pro-

vided excellent cover and truly close supporting fires. Their accuracy was outstanding and again everyone's voice on the radio sounded as if he were asking for landing instructions at *Downing* or *Cairns*.

I was somewhat amused by *WO Hardin*, who throughout the entire operation, had one radio tuned to the Armed Forces network in Saigon providing a background of popular music. Just a routine day's work! *Major McNair* was very kind to make me an honorary member of the "*Soc Trang Tigers*" as a result of having flown a combat mission with his unit, and the patch he forwarded me is displayed prominently on my Pentagon office wall.

"Gung Ho" mechanics

At the invitation of my old friend, *Major Chuck Carlson*, I spent a half day with his 195th Assault Helicopter Company participating in a long range patrol. Again, professionalism and outstanding leadership were the order of the day in this unit. I also had an opportunity to visit *Chuck's* unit area and to observe his maintenance and supply operations and how the outfit was living and maintaining their equipment.

I was most impressed with *Chuck's* maintenance and supply operations, and the resulting high in-commission rate of his aircraft. His outfit (like most others in RVN) had done a lot of construction to make life more comfortable in their base camp.

I would be grossly remiss if I failed to comment on the enlisted personnel in our aviation units. These mechanics, crew chiefs, and door gunners without exception, reflect the same spirit, enthusiasm, and "*Gung Ho*" attitude that the aviators themselves have,

and when you realize that these aircraft are out most of the day and many times far into the night with maintenance performed in the wee hours and ready for another day, then these men behind the scenes deserve a tremendous amount of credit.

Write!

Now the purpose of this letter is not so much to pass on these experiences, nor to give a well-deserved pat on the back to those involved. My real purpose is to urge the Army Aviator to *write* and *record* his experiences.

There are still thousands of people in and out of the military who know little or nothing about Army aviation and the unique capabilities it is providing to the combat commanders in Vietnam. Many people require a sort of "*primer*" on the current Army aviation's tactics and techniques, one that can best be illustrated by combat examples.

The data banks

Now I am enough of a realist to know that few men are inspired to sit down and write combat experiences *after* a particular hard day over a hot landing zone. It may even be a great effort to get off a short note to one's loved ones saying that all is well. But there are lulls (and there is time after a tour) to jot down some of the special things you have seen and experienced. Then pass them on to your superiors or to appropriate media* where they can become part of a "*data bank*" for the future.

The philosopher *Santayana* said, "*Those who cannot remember the past are condemned to relive it.*" Many of you know that we in Army aviation have had to re-learn many lessons of World War II and Korea in Vietnam. The recent body of airmobile expertise that has been developed in the last couple of years must be documented completely for many purposes besides those of the historian. Doctrine, training, missions, new concepts, and future aircraft depend on the rationale proven in combat.

So blow your own trumpet! Write!

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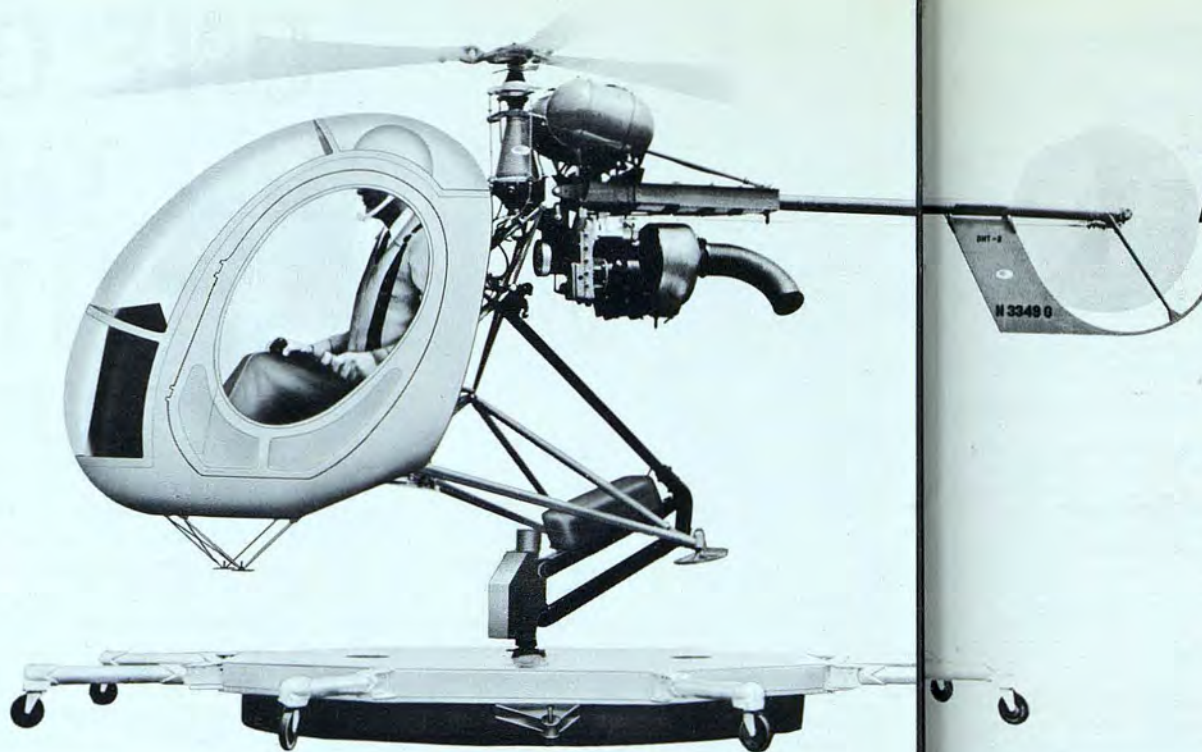

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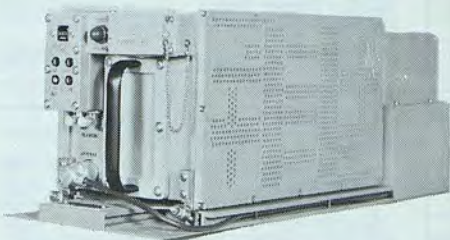
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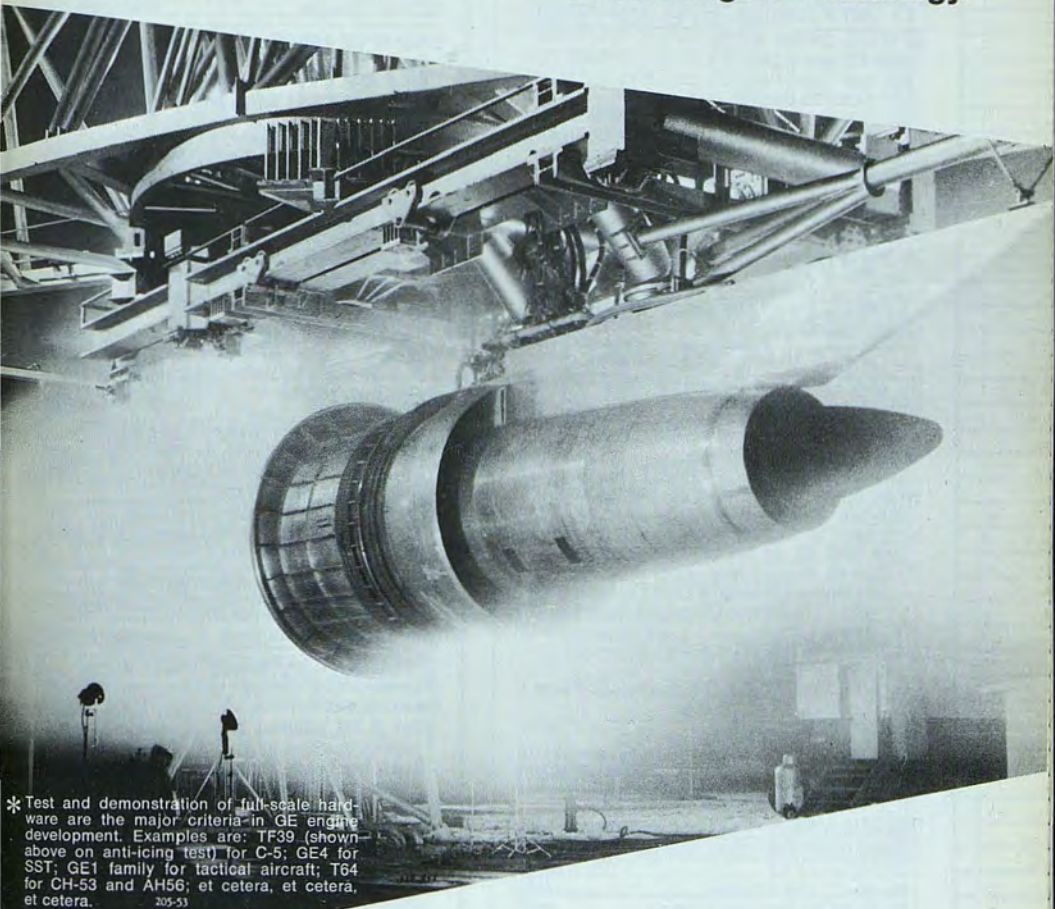
