1. (U) Reference: USARV Regulation 220-10, Sponsorship of Incoming Units.
2. (C) Request the programmed location for the 238th Aviation Company (Aerial Weapons) and the 587th TC Detachment (Aircraft Maintenance) be changed from Pleiku (Holloway AAF) to An Khe.
3. (C) The stationing of the 238th Aviation Company at An Khe places the unit where it can fulfill current tactical requirements for armed helicopter support in the coastal area of Binh Dinh and Phu Yen Provinces. In addition this proposed stationing plan will not adversely effect the units capability for immediate deployment to the western border areas to counter major enemy forces attacking out of Cambodian sanctuaries.
4. (U) The proposed change has been coordinated with the installation coordinators at Holloway and An Khe. Sufficient billets and maintenance hangars are immediately available at An Khe. Revetments and hardstand can be constructed with minimum engineer effort.
