

USARV COURTS MARTIAL ANALYSIS, FY 71

OBJECTIVE: To maintain discipline within the command.

ANALYSIS: During the 4th Qtr, FY 71, the total court-martial cases increased to 1,271 as compared with 1,134 in the 3d Qtr, FY 71. The number of general courts-martial increased from 62 to 85; the special courts-martial adjudging bad conduct discharges increased from 62 to 118; the special courts-martial increased from 894 to 933; and the summary courts-martial increased from 116 to 135. The rate per thousand increased substantially in all four categories over the respective rates for the 3d Qtr, FY 71.

ACTIONS/FUTURE OUTLOOK: The number of all types of courts-martial increased substantially during the 4th Qtr, FY 71. The total number of general courts-martial and bad conduct special courts-martial increased by 64 percent over the 3d Qtr, FY 71. The increase was due primarily to the rise in narcotic offenses. The number of narcotic cases is not expected to decrease materially during the 1st Qtr, FY 72, and the number of courts-martial cases should remain relatively constant or increase slightly.
