SUBJECT: Monthly Highlights for the month of April 1969

1. The 155th Assault Helicopter Company continued to provide effective support for the 23rd ARVN Division and units with operations in the II Corps Tactical Zone. The company also displayed its aggressiveness in dealing with the many TAC-Emergency operations that occurred in the Bu Prang area and north of Ban Me Thuot in the vicinity of the Mewal Plantation. These operations for the month of April yielded a large number of enemy KIA's and a large amount of captured equipment. The success of these operations can be attributed to the timely and effective support that the "Stagecoaches" rendered to units involved.
2. Camp Coryell came under attack twice during the month of April. The first attack came on the 6th of April. During this engagement the enemy damaged ten helicopters and two vehicles. On the 25th day of the same month, the enemy fired ten rounds of 82mm mortars and succeeded in inflicting light damage to five of our aircraft and to one transient aircraft.
3. Training programs within the company are now showing results. Emphasis has been put on the following training topics:

- a. CBR
- b. Weapons Safety
- c. Weapons Familiarization

The company continued to update and reinforce its standardization program for aviators with an emphasis to night flying, strong emphasis on standardization of maneuvers, and additional emphasis on safety. The training and safety programs in the company are constantly being improved with updating of training records and training classes.
