The 129th Aviation Company (Aslt Hel) was organized at Fort Campbell, Kentucky on 1 August 1965. It departed the states by ship on 30 September and arrived at Cam Ranh Bay in October. On 15 December it was declared operational and received its baptism under fire on 2 January 1966 when operational missions commenced. Since that time the company has earned a fine reputation supporting units of the 101st Airborne Division, Republic of Korea "Tiger Division, the 47th Infantry Regiment, ARVN and 22nd ARVN Division. Since its arrival in country, the company has made 31 moves.

The fighting elements consist of two airlift platoons equipped with eleven UH-1H's each and an armed platoon of six armed AH-1G's. To support them we have the organic Service Platoon and normal administrative and logistical components. Our home base is at Lane Army Heliport and all elements are presently operating at this location.

To provide tactical and logistical aviation support to the Capital (ROK) Infantry Division.
