SUBJECT: Detailed Chronological Sequence of Significant Events
1 August - 31 October 1967

1. (U) General: This detailed summary of significant events is extracted from the Daily Journal (J), Daily Intelligence Summary (I), Daily OPREP-5 (W), Daily Allocation Report (A), JSAFIDR (Shot At Reports) (R), After Action Report File (R), and covers the period 1 August 1967 - 31 October 1967.
