Constituted 8 December 1967 in the Regular Army as the 123d Aviation Battalion, assigned to the 23d Infantry Division, and activated in Vietnam

Inactivated 7 November 1971 in Vietnam and relieved from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division

Assigned 17 December 1985 to the 101st Airborne Division and activated at Fort Campbell, Kentucky

Relieved 16 September 1987 from the 101st Airborne Division and reorganized and redesignated as the 123d Aviation, a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System, with Headquarters at Fort Ord, California


