Constituted 8 December 1967 in the Regular Army as Company B, 123d Aviation Battalion, an element of the 23d Infantry Division, and activated in Vietnam

Inactivated 7 November 1971 in Vietnam and relieved from assignment to the 23d Infantry Division

Activated 17 December 1985 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, as an element of the 101st Airborne Division

Inactivated 16 September 1987 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and relieved from assignment to the 101st Airborne Division

Withdrawn 17 September 1989 from the Regular Army, allotted to the Army Reserve, and redesignated as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 2d Battalion, 123d Aviation; concurrently assigned to the Fourth United States Army and activated at St. Paul, Minnesota (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)


