1. Attached CHLL has been reviewed and the following comments are submitted:
  - a. Reference item concerning "Frequencies assigned an Air Cavalry Troop," page 13, para 2d(1). FM frequencies are assigned on a repetitive basis based on non-interference due to location and range. This criteria is at times ineffective because of the increased range attained when FM radios are mounted in aircraft. However, extra frequencies which are free of interference is an excellent solution to an annoying problem.
  - b. Reference item concerning "Painting of Light Observation Helicopters," page 14, para 2f(1). Concur. A similar paint scheme should also be adopted for the OH-58 helicopter.
2. Concur with all other paragraphs and command action.
