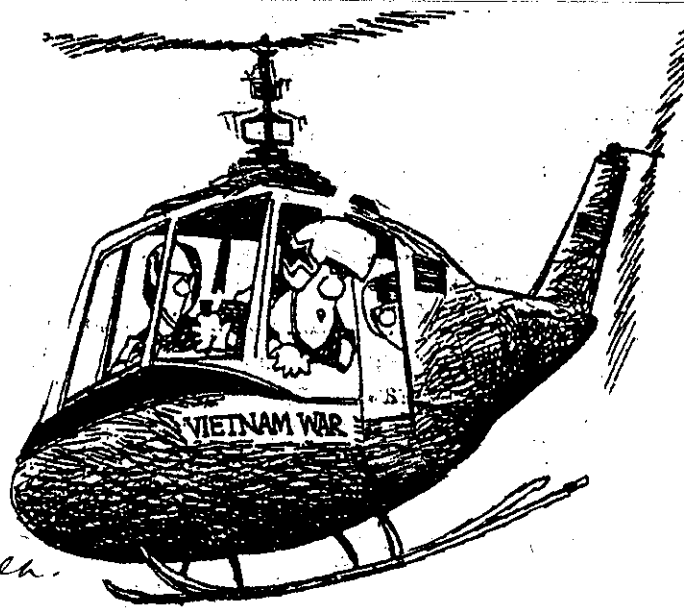


Be there!
