Casting dog for track has been unsucessful on the most part because of numerous scents in area. A fourth team was activated on 19 Sep 69 and will continue to operate in Song Be area. Unit now has three forward areas at Quon Loi, Tay Ninh, and Song Be. Transportation of teams to forward area from Phuoc Vinh is barely satisfactory. Weather has greatly reduced sign at most contact sites and time is usually limited to locate and follow before rain washes out scent and sign.
