Lessons Learned as turned in by Apache teams during the period from 15 July to 15 Aug 69.

1. On final during Blue insertions make sure you're lined up on proper prescribed heading. Last minute heading changes can be dangerous.
2. Before taking off in any aircraft make sure that all the cowling and access doors are secure and main rotor blades untied.
3. If QRF is in the field, insure that he is in pickup posture.
4. Make sure that all Blues' weapons are clear until they are on short final to LZ.
5. Make periodic check of repelling gear in UH-1H models.
