

Dear Mr. Law:

Enclosed are our working bibliographies and pertinent pages from Shelby Stanton's Vietnam Order of Battle (Ref), on the 17th Cavalry Regiment during Vietnam.

If unable to visit, you can make use of our lending and copying services. Many post-1914 imprints, as well as those with checkmarks or asterisks on the enclosed lists, may be borrowed via interlibrary loan procedures initiated at your local library. Up to six items at a time may be borrowed for a period of sixty days. Periodicals and manuscript materials do not circulate, but photocopies may be purchased. Those charges are \$3.50 for the first six pages and \$.10 per page thereafter, up to 100 pages per patron per year. Checks or money orders should be made payable to "Finance Officer," but should be sent directly to this office.

Retired unit records are located at the National Archives, 4205 Suitland Road, ATTN: Vietnam Records Project, Washington, DC 20409.

You are cordially invited to visit the Military History Institute, which is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., except federal holidays. Enclosed is a brochure that describes in general our holdings and services.
