NOTE: The previous quarter's history reported total Group aircraft losses at 33: 15 HH-3Es, 10 HH-43E/Ts, 3 HH-53B/Cs, 3 HU-16s, and 2 HC-130Ps.

Research has proven these figures to be slightly incorrect. The corrected Group aircraft losses should be 32: 14 HH-3Es, 11 HH-43E/Ts, 3 HH-53B/Cs, 2 HU-16s, and 2 HC-130Ps.

In addition, there were 4 aircraft losses in the 38ARRSg prior to the activation of the 3ARRGp. These losses were: 2 HH-43E/Ts, 1 CH-3C, and 1 HU-16B.
