SUBJECT: Relocation of AHCs (U)

1. (C) This headquarters has been directed to study the possibility of moving either or both the 135th and the 335th AHCs from Bear Cat to Can Tho as a permanent change of station. Anticipated proposals most likely will encompass one of the three courses of action listed below.

a. Course of Action #1. Simultaneous deployment of the 135th and 335th AHCs to Can Tho.

b. Course of Action #2. Relocate one AHC (either 135th or 335th) to Can Tho by 1 July 1969, to be followed by the remaining company at a later date.

c. Course of Action #3. Relocate only one AHC (135th or 335th) to Can Tho.

2. (U) To assist in this study request you provide this headquarters with an impact statement concerning aircraft maintenance support for each of the three courses of action outlined in paragraph one. Further request that impact statement include your anticipated space and facilities requirement and proposed maintenance support plan.
