1.(C) This section is preparing a study to determine if the HEC, 214th CAB, 147th ASHC, 162d AHC, 191st AHC, 135th AHC, 335th AHC and the 756th Med Det (OA) should be reassigned to the 164th CAG.

2.(C) The aforementioned units are currently assigned to the 12th CAG, with the exception of the 335th AHC which is assigned to the 17th CAG and attached to the 12th CAG. These units are providing aviation support to combat operations in the IV CTZ.

3.(C) It is anticipated that the 135th AHC and the 335th will relocate from Bear Cat to the IV CTZ within the next few months. If this action is approved all the units under consideration will be physically located in the IV CTZ except the 147th ASHC which will remain at Vung Tau.

4.(C) Request you provide comments as to the advantages and disadvantages the reassignment would have in your areas of interest as well as the overall impact to current administrative and logistical functions.
