Activated 9 August 1951 at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Inactivated 15 August 1952 at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Redesignated 10 May 1960 as the 45th Medical Company

Activated 6 June 1960 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 30 April 1971 in Vietnam

Activated 16 October 1988 in Germany


