Inactivated 12 November 1945 in France

Redesignated 27 September 1951 as the 159th Maxillo-Facial Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 24 January 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 18 October 1963 as the 159th Medical Detachment

Activated 24 December 1963 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Reorganized and redesignated 16 October 1988 as the 159th Medical Company


