Activated 25 July 1942 at Camp Gruber, Oklahoma

Reorganized and redesignated 25 November 1945 as the 247th Medical Detachment

Inactivated 28 February 1946 at Tunis, North Africa

Activated 1 August 1946 at Fort Mears, Alaska

Inactivated 21 April 1947 at Fort Meads, Alaska

Redesignated 27 September 1951 as the 247th Surgical Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 24 January 1953 in Korea

Redesignated 3 May 1968 as the 247th Medical Detachment

Activated 19 August 1968 at Fort Riley, Kansas


