### 283d MEDICAL DETACHMENT

Constituted 19 February 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 283d Medical Section

Activated 25 February 1944 at Camp Grant, Illinois

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1945 as the 283d Medical Detachment

Inactivated 1 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 29 December 1951 as the 283d Thoracic Detachment, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 22 January 1952 at Fitzsimons Army Hospital, Colorado

Inactivated 12 August 1952 at Fitzsimons Army Hospital, Colorado

Redesignated 18 October 1963 as the 283d Medical Detachment

Activated 1 December 1963 at Fort Lewis, Washington


