

Dear Mr. Konek:

We are responding to your two postcards of March 25, 1992, concerning our title list, Vietnam Casualty list information relating to Helicopter units, the handbook Managing Electronic Records, and the Code of Federal Regulations #20 and #23.

The Center for Electronic Records maintains electronic computer files appraised as having continuing value created by the Congress, the Courts, the Executive Office of the President, numerous presidential commissions, and nearly 100 bureaus, departments, and other components of executive branch agencies and their contractors.

We enclose the most recent version of the "Center for Electronic Records Title List (A Partial and Preliminary List of the Datasets in the Custody of the National Archives); not all entries are up-to-date. The Title List is organized by the archival Record Group in which each dataset is accessioned. Information contained in the list is maintained and updated in a computerized database by staff in the Center for Electronic Records. Currently included in the database are approximately 4,200 of over 12,000 datasets in the custody of the Center for Electronic Records. Because this is only a subset of all datasets in the custody of the National Archives, the current version of the Title List is considered partial and preliminary.

The Center has in its custody the Combat Area Casualties Current File (CACCF), a dataset created by the Department of Defense. It consists of records of deceased casualties from the Vietnam Conflict, including those who died or were declared dead while missing or captured. This dataset is current as of October, 1989. Enclosed is a handout describing the CACCF. Casualties who died as a result of an air crash are identified, and helicopter pilots and passengers have separate codes.

The fee for a computer printout of the records of the CACCF (58,152 casualties) is \$48.00. When creating a printout of CACCF we can sort the list using any of the variables in the dataset. The enclosed handout on CACCF includes a list of these variables. If you decide to order a copy of the printout, please let us know how you would like your printout sorted.

We also keep copies of full printouts of the records of the CACCF in our office for reference purposes and could answer questions you might have about a limited number of individuals.

Extracts of the CACCF in the form of state-level casualty lists are also available. The charge for each state list is \$4.50, with a minimum charge for mail orders of \$6.00. A description of the state list is also enclosed.

The Center also has custody of a database with records from the [Army] Adjutant General's Center, the Casualty Information System (TAGCEN). The database contains information on casualties suffered by all U.S. Army personnel and their dependents, worldwide, during the period 1961-1981. Records in this dataset contain the variable, major organization, in which individual divisions are listed, enclosed is a list of the Major Organizations in TAGCEN. There is no information that specifically identifies helicopter units. We have printouts of TAGCEN available sorted in a variety of ways for our reference use. Photocopies are available at \$0.25 per page. Enclosed is a handout describing TAGCEN.

For information about the paper records related to the Vietnam conflict that have been transferred to the National Archives, you may also wish to write to the National Archives' Suitland Reference Branch, National Archives and Records Administration, Washington, DC 20409.

As for your request for information on the Code of Federal Regulations, General Records Schedules 20 and 23, they are reprinted in the handbook Managing Electronic Records. We also enclose this handbook.

RECORD GROUP 330, OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE
[Southeast Asia] Combat Area Casualties Current File,
as of October 1989

The Combat Area Casualties Current File contains records with final data on U.S. military personnel who died as a result of hostilities (killed in action, died from wounds, died while missing, or died while captured) or other causes (died from illness or injury, nonhostile; died from other nonhostile causes; died while missing, nonhostile) in Cambodia, Communist China, Laos, North Vietnam, South Vietnam, or Thailand during the conflict in Southeast Asia. It also includes a record for one person whose casualty status is coded to indicate that he is still captured. There is one data record for each individual; 58,152 in all. Dates of death range from 1957 to 1989. The dataset was created by the Comptroller of the Office of the Secretary of Defense by directive of January 20, 1967. Responsibility for continuing maintenance was transferred in 1973 to the Directorate for Information Operations and Reports (DIOR), Washington Headquarters Services, a field activity of the Office of the Secretary of Defense.

The source for information stored in these records is Department of Defense Form 1300 (Report of Casualty) submitted to DIOR by each of the four military service branches. This dataset continues to be maintained by DIOR and staff there add, delete, or revise records as new information is received from the casualty offices of each of the military service branches. The dataset was most recently transferred to the National Archives in October, 1989; these records supersede previous transfers of the Combat Area Casualties File. Access to the final records of deceased casualties is completely open; selected variables have been identified as nonreleasable in the record for the still-captured casualty.

The variables potentially available in each final casualty record include: Military Service Branch, Country of Casualty, Type of Casualty, File Reference Number, Name of Casualty, [record] Processing Date, Service or Social Security Number, Military Grade, Pay Grade, Date of Death, Home of Record (city and state), Military Occupation Code, Birth Date, Reason (cause of casualty), Aircraft Involvement (air/non-air casualty), Race, Religion, Length of Service, Marital Status, Sex, Citizenship Status, Posthumous Promotion, Date Southeast Asian Tour Began (Date Missing or Captured in some records), Final Record Code, Body Status, Service Component, a 29-character comments field, and Province (of casualty).

State-level Lists of Casualties from the Vietnam Conflict (1957- 1989)

The Center for Electronic Records, National Archives and Records Administration, has custody of a dataset with records from the Office of the Secretary of Defense (Record Group 330) for U.S. military casualties from the Vietnam conflict. The Combat Area Casualties Current File includes final records for persons who died as a result of either a hostile or nonhostile occurrence in the Southeast Asian Combat Area, 1957- 1989, including those who died while missing or captured.

The Center has prepared state casualty lists by creating extracts from the dataset. Each state list incorporates selected data elements for all deceased casualties whose state "home of record," as identified by the serviceman or woman upon last entrance into military service, was that state. "Home of record" does not necessarily refer to the place of birth, residence of next of kin, place of longest residence, or other common uses of the term "hometown." In the Vietnam dataset place of "home of record" is identified as city/town and state.

The state lists include the following data for each casualty: name, rank or grade, branch of service, home of record, date of casualty, date of birth, category of casualty, and an indication of whether or not the body of the casualty was recovered. The state lists may be ordered in either of two formats: alphabetically by last name; or, alphabetically by "home of record." The charge for each state list is \$4.50, with a minimum charge for mail orders of \$6.00.

All requests must be prepaid. Checks should be made payable to the National Archives Trust Fund. Please send requests, taking care to specify the type of list(s) needed and the state(s) of interest, along with payment to Reference Services, Center for Electronic Records (NNX), National Archives and Records Administration Washington, D.C. 20408.

U. S. Army Casualties, 1961-81

The Center for Electronic Records, National Archives and Records Administration has custody of a database with records from the [Army] Adjutant General's Center, the Casualty Information System, 1961-1981, (TAGCEN), R.G. 407. The database was developed to centralize information on casualties (deaths and wounded) of all U.S. Army personnel, and their dependents, worldwide, during the period 1961-81. Data that identify the wounded are not released to the public in order to protect the privacy of persons presumed still to be living.

However, an extract of this database, representing records for U.S. Army active duty personnel who died, has been created for reference purposes. This extract has 60,484 casualty records, some of which are duplicates. Researchers may review printouts of this extract in the NNX reference room, or order selected pages from the printouts, on a cost recovery basis.

There are two important ways in which the information in the TAGCEN database supplements information on active-duty Army casualties found in the Department of Defense's Combat Area Casualty File (CACF), R.G. 330, also in the custody of the Center for Electronic Records. First, the TAGCEN database includes records for Army casualties worldwide during 1961-81, whereas the CACF database pertains to casualties incurred in Southeast Asia only. Secondly, the TAGCEN database includes a variable identifying the Major Organization, within the Army, with which the serviceman or woman served. Thus, it is potentially possible to identify casualties by the Major Organization with which each served. The Center for Electronic Records has two printouts sorted by Army Major Organization. The secondary sort for one copy is alphabetically by casualty name; the secondary sort for the other copy is by date of casualty.

A public use copy of complete records for the Adjutant General's Center Casualty Information System, 1961-81 (N=293,858) is available on computer magnetic tape for \$90, plus the cost of documentation (\$5.50). Printout pages of the extract described above can be copied for \$0.25 per page, with a minimum of \$6.00 per order. 

RECORD GROUP DESIGNATION INDICATES THE DEPARTMENT, AGENCY, ETC. THAT TRANSFERRED THE RECORDS TO THE NATIONAL ARCHIVES.

THE CODES USED IN THE FIELD "DATASET STATUS" PROVIDE A RELATIVE INDICATOR OF THE PROCESSING STATUS OF EACH DATASET. SINCE PROCESSING IS AN ONGOING ACTIVITY, THE INFORMATION CONCERNING STATUS IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. ALSO, PLEASE NOTE THAT BECAUSE THE NNX LIST OF DATASETS IS A PARTIAL LIST, MANY OF THE RECORD GROUPS IN THE DEPARTMENT/AGENCY INDEX ARE NOT REFLECTED IN THE LIST OF DATASETS.
